Malachai is the last of the OT Prophets Malachai assumes that from studying the earlier books, the principles he speaks of are known We should not read Bible books in a random order God leads us through a logical learning process beginning with Genesis \succ If we don't do this, we'll get it wrong!

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

- Genesis 1:1 -

A superscription for the entire Bible

 Superscription: Malachai 1:1 "A prophecy, the Word of Yehoveh to Israel through Mal'akhi"
 Not "prophecy", but "burden" (negative, weighty)
 Gen. 1:1 a superscription telling us the Universe had a beginning, God existed before that, He created everything

If we do NOT begin at Genesis 1:1, it causes confusion and misunderstandings

God IS Love (The Greek version)

> Vs. 2 begins the body of prophetic content
> From God's viewpoint, what is love?
> God says that love towards Him is obedience!
> The kind of "warm affection" emotional love is rejected as proof of love
> "Jacob I loved, Esau I hated"
> Luke 14:26

Misunderstanding the Love of God

Emotion of hate in humans is not the same as the condition or reaction of hate in God

God does NOT harbor psychological hate and anger

"Rejection" a better word than "hate"

- Covenant love involves an actual covenant made between two parties, and is based on reciprocal love
- Covenant love is only for those who are party to the covenant; for those who are not, it is covenant "hate"

- We get hung up on God's love and hate due to our wrong definitions
- Rom.9:10 13 Paul's midrash on Malachai
- God CHOSE Jacob for one destiny, and Esau for another
- God said the older would serve the younger
- We must NOT assign the same definitions of love and hate to both God and man

- God's relationship of love towards the Hebrews was based on the covenant with them
- Ahav (love) being used as a covenant term
- Sane (hate) also a covenant term
- God elected Jacob as covenant agent, but not Esau, and elected Isaac as agent, but not Ishmael
- But... Esau could CHOOSE to sign on to the covenant

Nabateans destroy Edom



- Edom suffered desolation as a proof of God's election of Jacob over Esau
- Edom warred with Israel starting in the time of King Saul
- David defeated Edomites
- Later Edom successfully rebelled.
- Edom helped Babylon attack Judah
- Nabateans destroyed Edom about the time Malachai was prophesying
- Jews were aware of what was happening to Edom
- God warned He could do the same to the Jews!

THE LACK OF RECIPROCAL LOVE = Faith Without Works

JAMES 2:14-26

Vs. 4 Edom says that even after being destroyed, they will just rebuild

> YHWH responds: "They can build, I will demolish"

The ultimate cause of Edom's destruction was God, not the Nabateans

Edom will be permanently known as the Land of Wickedness

God's judgment of hate can become irrepairable

YHWH OF HOSTS

GODHAS NO LIMITS!

God's power is not subservient to borders

- Second Burden begins in vs. 6 14
- The accusation of God is that the Levite Priesthood is no longer authentic
- Clergy of Israel = Priesthood Church clergy sees themselves as the gentile replacement of Levite Priesthood
- The sacred trust of clergy to teach the people God's Word has been broken
