Zechariah 7:11 – 12


- The passage says His people wouldn't listen to the Torah and the Prophets... God's Word
- Constantinian Church says none of this is for Christians to obey
- Constantinian Church re-structured Yeshua from His Hebrew mold into a Greek framework




A NEW GOD AND A NEW LAW One Hebrew Covenant separated out and turned over to **Constantinian** gentiles Those who challenge Church doctrines with biblical faith are deemed heretics (the Pilgrims) Things seem to go well for a while, then calamity arrives and God's people are unprepared

- The Church is not the church Christ created
- Yeshua did not come to reform the Synagogue or the Priesthood; He came to present the truth
- A faith group that denounces the Torah and the Prophets is wrong-mind and probably not salvageable
- Zech. 7:13 14
- A forensic autopsy of what Judah had done, its consequences and what NOT to do in the future

GOD'S PEOPLE SCATTERED

- The Covenants come with conditions
- Nations had no reason to show kindness to the exiles
- When Israel leaves the land, the land declines
 Mark Twain:

"...of all the lands there are for dismal scenery, I think Palestine must be the prince... desolate and unlovely..."

Jerome: "They are the promises of God which I unfold."

- A "Promise" is not a special instrument of God
- Covenants contain God's promises
- The issue always boils down to obedience
- God gives the covenant blessings only when His people obey

The Art of Biblical Poetry


- The first oracle is Hebrew poetry
- Do not apply too much precision to the words; it is the meaning and emotion we are to apprehend
- Qanah = zeal, zealous, jealous
- Chemah = fury or heat
- This is about God's intense love for Zion and His protective instinct to annihilate nations/people who harm Zion or His people

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The Glory of God departs

≻ Ezekiel 8:17 – 9:7

- > then... Ezekiel 10:4
- > then... Ezekiel 11:23
- The Glory is a particular manifestation of God



- Zech. 7:9 "Administer true justice..."
- Isaiah 1:21 "Once she was filled with justice..."
- Only with the return of The Glory can true justice be restored
- Ezekiel 48:35 "…on the name of the city will be Yehoveh Shamah (Yehoveh is there)"
- The ideal Jerusalem is embodied in the idea of Zion

- A new dynamic for Jerusalem
- Zechariah 8:4 5
- Merism = beginning, end, and everything in between
- Old and young, it's all about labor
- With spiritual peace comes material blessing
- Matthew 6:33 "...seek first his Kingdom... all these things be given to you as well..."




MISERY
