


- > Truth = emet Justice = mishpat
- Truth = reality at its deepest level
- Truthful = not lying
- It is the divine spiritual underpinnings of something that makes it truth
- Human religious institutions descend into replacing truth with doctrines and customs...beliefs

➤ Genesis 3:1 – 6


- God said not to <u>eat</u> the fruit
- Eve said not to <u>touch</u> the fruit (or eat it)
- Genesis 2:16 17 is truth
- This is what Church doctrines and Jewish traditions do
- Zech. 8:16 17 God says to set aside manmade traditions and return to truth
- Truth is in the Torah and the Prophets

THE 1ST TRUTH TO THE 1ST DOCTRINE



- Has the Holy Spirit given us permission to hear, find, or hold our own truth?
- True truth defines true morality
- Basic principle of good and evil is to love
- > 10 Commandments tell us how to love

Law of Moses gives us 600 case examples of good and evil behavior



Mishpat shalom is not properly characterized with "peaceful justice"

It means true justice that produces a divinely given well-being for the community

3rd foundational principle is to not form evil thoughts

4th foundational principle is to not perjure

FROM FASTING TO FEASTING





Martin Luther on Zech. 8:18 "... keep My commandments... such fasts (will) be over and come to an end..."

- Words of vs. 18 begin a new oracle
- 4 fasting days by the Judeans: 4th month, 5th, 7th, and 10th month
- > 2Kings 25 siege of Jerusalem, armies break though the walls of the city, Temple burned
- > All 4 were manmade fasts



God does not command Bethel to end their fasts

When Judah finally lets go of their manmade customs and traditions that truth and well-being will come

> Amim = peoples (plural)


Most likely means Israelites and others who have made some cultural or faith identification with Israel

THE CITY & TOWN STRUCTURE



- "Inhabitants" that come to Jerusalem probably means the leaders Cities used to mean politically independent towns with kings, but came to mean a city with its surrounding towns
- * Appease the face of YHWH" means to submit to His absolute authority

"Come, let's go up to the mountain..."




Halak = must, at once, urgently

- The inhabitants are those who recognize YHWH authority
- An expanding scope over time
- Micah 4:2 same thought
- Primarily talking about the End Times
- Worshippers of God that do not know His ways
- Leaders have discouraged them from knowing info from Prophets and the Torah

- "When that time comes" = "in that day"
- > 10 denotes whole and complete
- To grab hold of the cloak means to follow, to have loyalty
- Elohim envisions
 God as the chief
 administrator
- No English word can describe both uses of "elohim" in the Bible
