




GOD LIVES IN HEAVEN, NOT ON EARTH

- The Temple, like Shabbat, was made for man, not for God
- Yehoveh had been satisfied with a tent !!


MAN'S DESIRES VS. GOD'S

- > 2Sam.7:1 7
- God's oracle to Shlomo is that ONLY trust and obedience will bring about God's promise to David (through Solomon)
- Mankind has always wanted to build awesome buildings to "honor God"
- YHWH is NOT honored by buildings, but MEN are!
- Only our trust, love and obedience to God matters for our righteousness



HOLY OF HOLIES IS CALLED THE *DEBIR* IN THIS CHAPTER


- > The **Debir**
- "Oracle" is a good literal translation
- > 20 x 20 x 20
- > 35 feet HWL
- Much gold used





- K'ruvim = Cherubim
- First used in the Wilderness Tabernacle on the lid of the Ark of the Covenant
- Solomon's Cherubim dominate the room, and go wall to wall, overwhelming even the Ark
- Wingspan of 10 cubits each, and wingtips touch

DOORS INTO THE HOLY OF HOLIES



NOT "into the sanctuary" but rather "into the debir" (the Holy of Holies)


Goes from the Holy Place into the Holy of Holies

Wooden doorframe

Olive wood doors withCherubim and palm trees


Same designs carved all over the interior of the entire Temple

THE TEMPLE WITH COURTYARDS



- > Door into the
- hekal (Temple) is made of fir/cedar
- Inner Courtyard for priests
- Intermediate courtyard for Israel (common folk)
- Outer Courtyard of the Women

1st KINGS 7: SOLOMON'S PALACE





PALACE COMPLEX

- Palace complex was 4 structures
- House of the Forest of Lebanon
- > Isaiah 10:34

HOUSE OF THE FOREST OF LEBANON

- A maze of cedar beams and posts
- > 100 X 50 cubits
- > 30 cubits high
- 15,400 sq.ft. as compared to the Temple's 3700 sq.ft.
- > All wood!





FOUR STRUCTURES


- Royal Palace (including Pharaoh's daughter's quarters)
- Hall of Judgment
 - Hall of Pillars
 - Forest of Lebanon

BUILDING STONES

- Some stone blocks were18 ft. long (20 + tons)
- All were precisely cut and finished
- Foundation stones
 usually modified
 boulders because they
 were underground




HIRAM, THE WORKER OF BRONZE



- This Hiram is of Israelite heritage
- Father from Naphtali, mother from Dan
- > Ex. 36:1
- Two pillars, each 18 cubits high (32 ft.)
- > Hollow bronze tubes
- Yakin = to be established
- Bo'az = strength is within

THE BRONZE (MOLTON) SEA

- A tank from which priests washed their hands and feet
- > Mare = Sea
- > 10 cubits (18 ft.) dia.
- > 5 cubits (9 ft.) high
- Probably cast in Timna
- 12 oxen, 4 groups of 3 each facing different compass directions





TEMPLE PLUMBING

- Molten Sea was about 4 inches thick
- Enormous weight!
- Held about 12,000 gallons of water
- Water had to be water from a moving source
- Mayim chayim = living water
- Holes in the feet of the oxen allowed for water pipes
