



1ST KINGS 16: THE PERVERSE KINGS OF ISRAEL

- Ba'sha's shameful end is recorded
- > C.F. Kiel "....something strange in the perversity... of the Kings of Israel...."
- The cause was spiritual blindness
- The golden calves were intended as graven images of the God of Israel
- The Israelites had not given up worshipping Yehoveh, but had mixed paganism in with it until their worship had become corrupt and futile




BA'SHA RULER OF NORTHERN KINGDOM


- Asa ruled over the southern kingdom of Judah
- Ba'sha wiped out Jeroboam, his son Nadav, and his dynasty
- Yehu pronounced a curse upon Ba'sha for his evil ways
- Ba'sha ruled for 20 years and died of natural causes

ELAH SUCCEEDS BA'SHA

- Elah reigned for only parts of 2 calendar years (883-882 B.C.)
- Elah continued to rule from *Tizrah*
- Tirzah was named after a daughter of Zelophehad
- Num.27: 1 − 7
- Located in Manasseh's tribal territory



ZIMRI ASSASSINATES ELAH



- Zimri a commander of chariots, not a popular commander
- When the army was away besieging Gibbethon, Zimri killed Elah
- Zimri killed all of Elah's family ga'al
- Ga'al = kinsman redeemer
- As a result all of Ba'sha's family bloodlines were terminated

"Following worthless vanities..."

- Habel = characteristics of vapor or breath
- Yishaq in Amos 7, meaning to play-around
- Israel ceased worshipping God in the ways He ordained, and instead did it in ways that pleased themselves
- The leadership held responsible because they were the only source of information
- Today individuals have Bibles and other resources available, so the individual is held responsible





ZIMRI RULES FOR ONLY 7 DAYS!

- Ba'sha killed of Jeroboam's line and Zimri killed off Ba'sha's line
- Army heard of Elah's death and did not want Zimri as king
- Omri led the army against Tirzah
- Zimri committed suicide by burning down the palace over his own head




OMRI GAINS A RIVAL

- "All Israel" means different things based on the context
- The Israelite civilians did not agree with *Omri* seizing power
- Tibni son of Ginath was preferred by the people, while Omri was the army's choice
- > The Northern Kingdom is now split into two factions
- Name of Northern Kingdom evolves: sometimes is called *Israel* (a national name), sometimes is called *Ephraim* (a tribal name)
- Tibni died after 4 years of struggle, and Omri ruled a total of 12 years.

A NEW CAPITAL CITY LOCATION

- Omri purchased a hilltop from Shemer
- Named the place Shemeron, which evolved to Shomron (Samaria)
- Steep approaches, lots of water
- Omri also led the people in the ways of Jeroboam



AHAV MARRIES JEZEBEL



- Asa still king over Judah
- Ahav represented the worst leadership of Israel yet
- Izevel = Jezebel, daughter of King Eshbaal
- Ahav built upon the bad leadership before him and took the step of renouncing Yehoveh
- He set up Ba'al worship throughout the north
- God raises up prophets, starting with Elijah, to counter this atrocity

THE INEVITABLE HAPPENS

- God is raising up a new movement of pastors, teachers, and leaders trained outside the seminaries to counter the great apostasy within His Church
- Israel, the Jewish people, and the Torah is what this movement revolves around
- Barna Group survey of 2009:
- > 34% of Christians believe in absolute moral truth
- > 50% believe that the Bible is accurate in principles
- Most believe that other religions' sacred books are on par with the Bible
- 40% believe in the spiritual influence of angels and demons
- > 27% believe that Satan actually exists

STEPS AND STAGES BY POOR LEADERSHIP
