


HANNAH'S SONG AND GOD'S NATURE

- > 1st Sam. 2: 1 10
- A Psalm explaining God's activity on earth
- A Psalm of gratitude and thanksgiving
- > Sh'mu'el = Samuel
- A definite link between Hannah's Song and the letters to the 7
 Churches of Asia in the Book of Revelation



REVELATION CHAPTERS 1, 2, 3

"To him who overcomes..." is the same as "To him who wins the victory"

THE 7 REWARDS FOR THE OVERCOMER

- > 1) May eat from the Tree of Life
- > 2) Will not be harmed by the 2nd death
- > 3) White stone is "entry ticket" to the Marriage Supper of the Lamb
- > 4) Will rule over nations
- > 5) Given absolute purity, introduced to the Father, guaranteed to live in God's presence
- 6) May serve at the new Temple and live in the New Jerusalem
- > 7) May sit with Christ on His throne

IT'S ABOUT GOD'S PEOPLE, NOT PAGANS


Both Hannah's Song and Revelation 1,2,3 have NOTHING to do with pagans

This is NOT a matter of the Church vs. the World

- This IS about what goes on within the walls of the Churches
- This IS about Jesus dividing and separating from within churches!



"Lord, Lord, didn't we prophesy in your Name....?"



- "Get away from Me, I never knew you...."
- In Hannah's day the Priesthood was a mess!
- In Revelation the NEW priesthood of Believers is a mess!
- Was Yeshua talking to pagans? NO!!
- He was addressing those who think themselves to be in Harmony with Christ


ONLY 30% SAVED??!!

- Billy Graham says:
- 30% of church goers actually Believers
- Less than 2% of all who came forward at his Crusades continued in the Faith
- Conclusion? Many who think they are safe in Jesus are not
- Why? Because the God they believe in is not the biblically defined God, it is the god they have created in their minds




"Come out of her, My People!"

- > Rev. 18:1 5
- What is an "apostate" church?
- Claims Christ as head, calls on Jesus' authority, but has traded God's commands for something else
- The "Whore of Babylon" represents the Unfaithful who claim to be God's representatives



SAMUEL 2:11 – 17 THE APOSTATE PRIESTHOOD



- Sh'mu'el began serving God as a kindergarten-aged child
- Eli's sons were priests at Shiloh
- They would forcefully take portions of sacrificial meat that wasn't theirs
- Their bigger crime was against God for robbing what was His
- The sacrifice was brought into contempt
