
JEHOIAKIM IS JUDAH'S NEW KING




- Y'hoyakim = Jehoiakim
- Y'ho'achaz the 1st to replace Josiah
- Neco removed Y'ho'achaz and replaced him with Y'hoyakim
- In 605 B.C. Babylon took over the region from Egypt



- New Babylonian Empire takes over the Assyrian Empire
- Media another regional power allies with Babylon
- Y'hoyakim rebelled against Nebuchadnezzar by refusing to pay his agreed-to tribute

BABYLON AGAIN FIGHTS EGYPT

- 601/600 B.C.Babylon battlesEgypt in the Sinai
- No victor, both sides suffer big losses
- 2nd Kings 24:7
- Y'hoyakim thought this was a good opportunity to rebel because of Babylon's weakness
- Bad idea!



2ND KINGS 24: THE FALL OF JERUSALEM



- 586 B.C. was NOT when Jerusalem fell to Babylon
- Rather it was when the Temple was destroyed
- Y'hoyakim was king when Nebuchadnezzar first took over Jerusalem, but intact
- 2nd Kings 24:2 says it was YHWH who sent troops from Aram, Moab, Amon and the Chaldeans to attack Jerusalem
- Chaldean = Babylonian






DOES GOD PUNISH HIS OWN?

- God incited Judah's enemies to destroy Judah
- God is on Babylon's side !!
- Different than End Times, people of the north, who are being lured to their destruction
- Sins of Manasseh are being manifested in the people of Judah
- Y'hoyakim, although not a good king, was not being blamed for Judah's judgment
- It is the <u>people</u> of Judah who are responsible

JEREMIAH 27: THE YOKE OF SUBJUGATION

- On earth, Babylon will hold the reins of the yokes
- > In Heaven, God is directing it
- Jeremiah 27:5 "...I give it to whom it seems right to Me"
- Couldn't God have reacted in some other way than severe punishment?
- Why not show unlimited mercy to Judah?
- Many Believers think that God will not punish His own
- So shouldn't we feel upset that He was wrong to punish Judah?



WAS JUDAH'S REDEMPTION REVOKED?

- Nothing indicates Judah's redeemed status has changed
- God will at times show mercy, and at other times punish
- God intends for Judah to submit to Babylon
- Jeremiah 27:8
- God warns that those who fight against Babylon, fight against Him!!
- Jeremiah warned Jehoiakim NOT to rebel, but he did and the Lord punished Judah!

- God does not have unlimited patience on His people or upon wicked nations
- Are we more or less moral than 40, 20, or 10 years ago?
- Do people want the truth, or false messages of tolerance, prosperity, and happiness?



- The Lord says don't listen to those who say everything is fine, things are getting better, God will always deliver us
- Jeremiah 27:16 A message directly to the religious establishment not to resist Babylon
- ➤ HOPE !! There is always hope in the Lord ! Deut. 24:16
- God says He will bring Judah back
- Same pattern as the exodus from Egypt
- After responsible generation dies off, the next generation can come to the land with a clean slate
