

AMNON IS DEAD



- > Avishalom has Amnon killed for the rape of his sister Tamar
- He used the blueprint that his father David used to have Uriyah killed
- David was forgiven by God on an eternal basis, but David would suffer as one cursed-on-earth
- We are given a similar kind of forgiveness in Christ
 - Romans 7:14 25




ABSALOM FLEES TO GESHUR

- David tormented day and night knowing his sin was causing his family's disintegration
- Avishalom as the chief conspirator bore blood-guilt
- David did not "banish" Absalom, he fled on his own accord
- ➤ Ba'al Hatzor, where Amnon was killed


DAVID'S HEART <u>AGAINST</u> ABSALOM

- > 2nd Sam. 13:13 14:33
- Avishalom remained in Geshur for 3 years
- King's lev was al Avishalom
- Lev = heart = mind, conscious thoughts
- > AI = on, over, AGAINST
- Alfred Edersheim: if David's heart was FOR Absalom he would not have left him in Geshur for 3 years, and then refuse to see him for 2 more years



WHY WAS JOAB SO CONCERNED AS TO WANT ABSALOM BACK?

- First: David getting old. Joab concerned that he NOT be replaced by David's successor
- Second: Avishalom was popular, handsome, everything the people wanted so Joab thought Absalom would be the next king thus it would be wise to support him







WISE WOMAN FROM TEKOA

- Joab tries to facilitate reconciliation between David and Absalom
- Prophet Amos from Tekoa
- Chakam ishshah = wise woman
- NOT a sorcerer or prophetess
- Yo'av tells the woman exactly what to say to David

WOMAN TELLS KING DAVID HER SAD STORY

- Joab must have personally arranged for the audience
- She is a widow
- Two sons were in the field
- No witnesses
- One son murdered the other
- Family go'el hadam wants to kill the surviving son as retribution
- If surviving son dies then her husband will have "neither name nor survivor anywhere on this earth"








THE "WIDOW'S" PROBLEM

- Only hope of survival was from male family members
- Law of Moses says sons are responsible
- If a man has no sons (due to barren wife or sons' deaths) then his afterlife essence is terminated
- Speaking a person's name was thought to have a supernatural effect



CIVIL JUSTICE

- Torah is clear that a murderer MUST be executed
- Go'el hadam was generally responsible to execute the murderer
- Author hopes to have the listener remember Cain and Abel
- Should David allow Torah justice to take place?
- Should David block the blood avenger for the good of the widow?
- David vows: "Not one of your son's hairs will fall to the ground"
- Absalom caught by his hair and died

TORAH DEMANDS BLOOD FOR BLOOD

- Exodus 21:12 17 "Whoever attacks a person and causes his death must be put to death..."
- Not ALL killing is murder. Accidental killing, self defense, killing in battle are not murder
- Numbers 35:14-21 "You are to give.....cities of refuge..." "...or out of hostility strikes him with his hand so that he dies.....he must be put to death...."
- Varying degrees of both JUSTIFIABLE killing and UNJUSTIABLE killing

HOW SHOULD DAVID DECIDE?

- Numbers 35:21 fits the situation
- No other option but death
- David allowed his personal sympathy to outweigh God's Law
- This was a case of confessed murder
- There is NO atonement for murder in the Law
- If the local society refuses to execute the murderer then the local society bears the bloodguilt
- This is because the society is being disobedient to God's Law



DAVID PARDONS THE MURDERER

- David was WRONG!
- The advent of Christ did NOT change the fact that we are obligated to execute murderers
- Judaism, due to humanitarianism, thinks execution is wrong
- Rabbis say that because there was no witness to WARN the murderer (or Absalom) then their crime is excused
- This twisted logic is to find a way to excuse David and continue to make him sinless





THE WHOLE EARTH IS UNDER BLOOD GUILT

- Modern secular society says human rights do not allow execution of murderers
- Lockerbie bomber released out of "mercy"
- Christianity thinks love has replaced justice
- Judaism thinks humanitarianism has replaced justice
- Love does NOT annul God's Laws and His justice on earth
