

### KING DAVID FLEES JERUSALEM

- Many vital principles are presented in 2<sup>nd</sup> Sam. 15
- David, although self indulgent and passive, springs into action upon the news of Absalom's rebellion
- David knew if he fought to hold on to his throne that there would be great destruction and death
- He knew that this was a consequence of God's judgment upon him11







- King fleeing eastward, through the Kidron Valley and over the Mt. of Olives
- Ittai the Gittite meets with the King and David offers him an opportunity to return and not be attached to a deposed king
- Temol = yesterday, recently
- > Nokri = alien, stranger

Goleh = exile

#### ITTAI IS CONFRONTED BY DAVID



- David says he cannot offer an earthly future for Ittai and his men
- Chesed and emeth usually translated as "Mercy and truth" or "Grace and truth"
- Chesed describes a spiritual state of being, a relationship
- Chesed is a concept more than a word



- > A car as an illustration of *chesed*
- Chesed is a concept that is made up of many components and attributes
- Chesed includes the components of faithfulness, kindness, love, loyalty, mercy, truthfulness and grace (and more!)
- Chesed is fundamental in God's idea of relationship, both personal and as pertains to covenants

# THE COMPLEX REDUCED TO OVER-SIMPLIFICATIONS

- No single word in English or Greek expresses the concept of *chesed*
- God has often been reduced and over-simplified to having one attribute: LOVE
- God IS love, but also is wisdom, healing, lawgiver, judge, warrior, full of wrath, and more.....
- "Grace" is far too narrow of a definition of chesed






# CHESED INVOLVES DOING!

- Messiah's followers have obligated ourselves to God and to His commandments
- Matt.7:21 "....only those who <u>DO</u> what my Father in heaven wants.."
- James 2: "....faith, by itself, unaccompanied by ACTIONS, is dead"
- Chesed is to be reciprocated!






### THE WAY OF THE WILD OLIVE TREES



- "....the army passed on before him along the Way of the Wild Olive Trees....."
- Several pathways crossed the Mt. of Olives
- Ittai's army, led by Ittai the gentile, follows the Way of the Wild Olive Trees
- Romans 11
- Principle: A gentile can be made part of Israel's saving covenants by God's chesed through Messiah, but does have to become a Hebrew or become a naturalized Israelite

# THE ARK RESTS AS THE PEOPLE CROSS-OVER THE KIDRON



- Tzadok and a procession of Levites with the Ark of the Covenant arrives
- Probably in imitation of the Ark and Levites in the Jordan River as the people cross over
- TWO High Priests: Tzadok and Evyatar
- Tzadok of the proper line of Eleazar
- Evyatar illegitimate (from the line of Ithamar, through Eli)

### WEEPING AND HEAD COVERED

- Tzadok and Evyatar told to take the Ark back to Jerusalem
- David felt he had no right to the presence of the Ark
- Head covered and barefoot was a sign of contrition and repentance
- David is informed of Achitofel's treachery
- He is Bathsheba's grandfather



# TZADOK AND EVYATAR TO BE DAVID'S SPIES



- At the summit of the Mt. of Olives David meets Hushai
- A formal worship place at the top of the Mt. of Olives
- Many throughout Israel
- Hushai too old to accompany David
- Hushai will work as a team with Tzadok, Evyatar and their 2 sons as informers



- 2<sup>ND</sup> SAMUEL 16 David meets many folks as he exits Jerusalem
- Tziva, Mephibosheth's servant, meets David bring supplies for David's exile
- David expected that Mephibosheth himself would come, since David had shown him such chesed
- Tziva came with a slanderous story about Mephibosheth
