- Pharisees created Oral Torah (Tradition)
- Yeshua criticized the Pharisees over Tradition of the Elders Matt.15:1 – 3
- Sadducees shunned Tradition, followed only the written Laws of Moses (Torah)
- Synagogue and Temple were rival systems with separate leadership structures
- After destruction of Jerusalem Sadducees lost their power and Pharisees became Rabbis who ruled Judaism until our times

SANHEDRIN: THE JEWISH SUPREME COURT



This is where Peter and John were being examined High Priest was the President of the Sanhedrin Not a Biblically ordained legal body Did not exist until 160's B.C. Terminated 70 A.D. Annas "High Priest" was an honorary title Sitting High Priest was Caiaphas

Jailed overnight

- Court didn't dispute that the healing was real
- The issue for the Sadducees was theology
- "Filled with the Holy Spirit" = special divine inspiration
- > Matt.10:18 20
- Yeshua not saying that we are not to prepare

"By what name did you do this?"



- In an intense teaching environment for up to 3 years !
- Higher learning for Jews was religious training
- Yeshua and Disciples didn't have Bibles to carry around
- After Salvation, immersion
- After immersion, study of God's Word
- Am Ha'eretz = people of the land, a derogatory term meaning no systematic education

12 DISCIPLES TAUGHT BY YESHUA





- Peter questions their motives for this examination
- Using Yeshua's name caused fear because only weeks earlier they had Yeshua killed and created a martyr
- Peter turned the tables, and went from defense to offense
- Peter uses this opportunity to preach the Gospel and begins with the well known Psalm 118

≫ THE GOSPELACCORDING TO THE ≫ OLD TESTAMENT

- Gospel of Salvation is given in the Old Testament
- Yeshua taught the Gospel from the Old Testament
- Disciples taught the Gospel to Jews from the Old Testament
- Paul taught the Gospel to the gentiles from the Old Testament
- There would not be a New Testament until nearly 2 centuries after the Cross
- The New Testament is an irreplaceable part of the Bible
- Venerable Bede 700's A.D., early Church Father
- His Commentary on Acts of the Apostles chapter 4

"....so that from two Testaments and from two peoples there might rise up a building of one and the same faith"

Psalm 118 is part of the Hallel > Agreed by Christians and Jews as Messianic Yeshua used it of Himself Mark 12:10 Peter's use of the "rock" was appropriate but inflammatory > The same Sadducees who wanted to arrest Yeshua, are who Peter and John stand before



*"…salvation in no one else…no other name under heaven…by whom we must be saved…"*Two (Dual) Covenant Theology says 1 path to salvation for Jews, another for gentiles
Peter was speaking to Jews, at the Sanhedrin, when he spoke those words (no gentiles were present)

THE SANHEDRIN DELIBERATES



 Their accents gave away the Disciples as Galileans

Rabban Gamaliel II

"...uncultured person not sin-fearing....ignorant person not pious..."

 Sanhedrin admits a miracle healing happened through Peter and John

Sanhedrin reaction? Don't do it anymore!!

IGNORANCE OF THE LAW <u>CAN</u> BE AN EXCUSE

- Acts 3:17 "...you did not understand the significance of what you were doing...."
- But now that the crowd understood, their only avenue was to repent
- Peter and John broke no law, so they couldn't be punished
- But, Sanhedrin made new law and explained they cannot use Yeshua's name anymore
- Next time they could be punished, because they knew the law



PSALM 2



- Peter and John returned to their friends, they all rejoiced and prayed
- Prayer began with Psalm 146, then Psalm 2
- Pesher = interpreting Bible as applied to current events
- Psalm 2:9 " break them with an iron rod"

Rev. 2:26 -27 "rule with a staff of iron..."
