




HIGH TECH?

- Does Revelation really speak of Nuclear weapons?
- Nature can unleash more devastation than man can ever hope to
- Principle: God creates cataclysmic judgments, not men

REVELATION JUDGMENTS MIMIC THE PLAGUES ON EGYPT

- Strokes on Egypt were real and tangible
- Scholars tend to accept the Egypt plagues
- Why are Revelation judgments seen more as metaphor than reality?
- They will be things of nature, but greatly amplified
- Revelation pattern established in Torah





SIGNS AND MIRACLES TO BE REMEMBERED


- Yehoveh has used Egypt for Israel's sake
- Our happiness and comfort is secondary to bringing in the Kingdom of God
- The hail has destroyed the crops, and the Locusts eat what's left
- Pharaoh's magicians beg him to give in

"BUT WHO AMONG YOU WILL GO?"

- Pharaoh agrees to let Israel go to worship God, but wants some to stay as hostages
- Moses answers: ALL!
- Pharaoh now knows Israel intends to leave permanently, and so changes his mind
- This 8th plague, Locusts, comes on an east wind
- It is a DEADLY stroke because the food supply is destroyed
- Pharaoh says, "I have sinned against God"



DARKNESS DESCENDS UPON EGYPT



- > The 9th plague
- > 3rd stroke of the 3rd set of strokes, unannounced
- The most terrible of them all
- Chosek =
 spiritual darkness
- > Owr = spiritual light
- This did NOT happen in Goshen
- A darkness that could be "felt"
- Light could not penetrate this darkness

CHAMSIN


- There are natural happenings like fog that seem to absorb light
- Chamsin is a kind of dust storm
- The air becomes charged with static electricity
- The dust filters indoors, and oil lamps would not work
- In the present world, light and darkness exist side-by-side



PHARAOH AGAIN CALLS FOR MOSES

- Pharaoh tries to bargain; people can go, but their livestock must stay
- Moses says NO!
- Moses needed all that Israel possessed because he wasn't sure what God would demand of them
- Principle: We are to submit all that we have and we are to Abba. Whatever we will NOT submit to Him, remains in bondage
- > Pharaoh says no.
- The end of hope of Redemption for Pharaoh and his nation has ended. Next...Judgment!

EXODUS 11: JUDGMENT!




- Judgment is the time when we all receive what is due us
- ALL, saved and unsaved, will be judged
- The Unsaved will be condemned, the SAVED will be forgiven
- 9 times Pharaoh was given to save his nation
- Judgment is all that is left and is now unavoidable
- Moses tells Pharaoh all firstborn will die, including the livestock

Y-H-W-H KILLED THE FIRSTBORN

- Not an "angel of death"
- ➤ The Lord says not only will Pharaoh release Israel, he will DRIVE Israel out
- Egypt would give the Israelites anything and everything to leave
- Egyptians are bitter to this day about what Israel took with them, and have even gone to court to try and recover it
- God makes a DISTINCTION between Israel and the world at large

GRAFTED-IN

- Egypt represents "The World"
- Romans 11:17 gentiles grafted into Israel's covenants
- Gentiles do NOT become Jews
- This grafting is from a spiritual perspective
- Nor, does a NON-believing Jew cease being a Jew
- Sanctification means "set-apart" (for God)





DARKNESS AT CRUCIFIXION

- Israel celebrated while Egypt cowered in the darkness
- Israel knew deliverance was near
- The world cowered in the darkness at Christ's crucifixion, but Heaven celebrated!
