
EXODUS 20:12, the 5th Word




"Honor your father and mother, so that you may live long in the land which Adonai (Yehoveh) your God is giving you".

God's Principles of the 10 Words aren't just for Israel. God's Principles are for ALL REDEEMED people.

Vs. 12: The "land"

- Land in Hebrew = adamah
- Adamah means earth, soil, ground, dirt, and can mean the non-water areas of our whole planet
- Adamah not generally used to refer to a specific nation or country
- Eretz is normally used when referring to the "land of Israel" or "land of Canaan"
- Our life on this earth will be blessed when we treat our parents with love and respect.



EX. 20:13, the 6th Word



> "Do not murder" In Hebrew "Do not ratsach" Ratsach means to kill **UNJUSTLY** Does NOT mean: to carry out an execution sentence, or to kill in self-defense, or to kill an enemy in battle Can even mean accidental, but generally includes the

idea of negligence

WHAT IS "UNJUST" KILLING?


- The Lord says ONLY He has the right to take a life
- Torah gives humans the task of assigning guilt or innocence BASED on God's Laws
- Yehoveh DELEGATES the task of exacting a blood penalty (death) to human governments
- Genesis 9 principle: "...whoever sheds the blood of man, <u>BY MAN</u> shall the guilty party's blood be shed...."

<u>NOT TAKING THE LIFE OF A</u> MURDER CHEAPENS LIFE

- Most societies have abolished the death penalty
- By the 2nd Temple Period the Sanhedrin RARELY ordered the death penalty
- The Romans DID allow the pronouncement of the death penalty, but the Jews had to ask the Romans to carry it out!
- Rabbi Gamaliel says that if the most radical of the Sanhedrin had their way (and abolished the death penalty), more innocent blood would be spilled as a result



EX. 20:14, the 7th Word



 "Do not commit adultery"
 <u>ADULTERY CAN ONLY OCCUR</u> <u>WITHIN THE CONTEXT OF A</u> <u>MARRIAGE UNION</u>

In God's eyes, this union is primarily SPIRITUAL in nature

Adultery is less about our **bodies** entering into unauthorized physical unions, than with our **spirits** entering into unauthorized unions

In human marriage only 2 authorized unions: 1) between husband and wife, and 2)between them and Yehoveh

Christ's union with Believers

- Bible speaks of this union in "marriage" terms
- Human marriage = union of man and woman
- Salvation = union (marriage) of Christ and man
- Believers not yet FULLY into a COMPLETED marriage to Christ
- In Bible times, betrothed couples were seen as married
- A marriage contract "Chethubah" was formed and immediately effective
- To become UNengaged required a legal divorce decree
- > Upon betrothal, the union began





Believers are BETROTHED to Christ

- <u>Right now</u>..... we are in union with Christ in SPIRIT
- After the Marriage Feast of the Lamb, we will be in union with Christ in PERSON
- > Adultery in Greek = moichos refers to infidelity in marriage
- Hebrew sense of adultery is unfaithfulness in a marriage union
- Unfaithfulness did NOT have to be sexual, it could be fraternizing or taking another's side 8





FORBIDDEN UNIONS

What or who we are in union with defines how Yehoveh sees us

Paul lists forbidden unions in 1 Cor.6

The term adultery in the Biblical sense means to engage in forbidden unions

Divorce and Re-marriage

- The sin of adultery is FORGIVABLE
- > Yeshua has already paid for it
- Paul (and Christ) speak on the subject of divorce, even set guidelines for divorce, in order that we do not sin further and in other ways
- Both make clear this is because in God's mercy, He knows man's hardened hearts, and makes provisions, BUT He does NOT excuse divorce.....it IS a serious sin!

EX. 20:15, the 8th Word

"Do not steal"

Hebrew for steal = ganab

Means to use deception to get something that is not yours. To be sneaky.



EX. 20:16, the 9th Word



"Do not give false evidence against your neighbor"


> Often taught simply "do not lie"

The meaning here is more in the sense of perjury, or false accusations

EX. 20:17, the 10th Word

- "Do not covet....."
- Means not to desire something that is not yours
- In Bible times, wealth was gained often by forcibly taking it from another.... This is the tribal way.
- Idleness can lead to covetousness

Exodus 20:15-23



Israel feared God and asked Moses to speak and hear for them

> Vs 17, 3 reasons Yahweh came to them in power and glory on Mt. Sinai:
> 1) To put Israel on trial
> 2) To put awe of God upon Israel

> 3) Israel learn not to sin


Ex. 20:20 NO other gods

- Not a repetition of the 2nd Word
- 2nd Word is primarily about making images and representations of Yehoveh

 Vs.20 is about making IDOLS, images of false gods



God determines where altars are to be built



The ONLY purpose for an altar is to sacrifice

ONLY the places God chooses for an altar is where blessing will be gained from sacrifice

Altars are not to be grand, for man's attempt to make an altar "better" than what God provided, is profane

WE are the Temple, the location of the altar, the place of sacrifice in the spirit of Yeshua.
