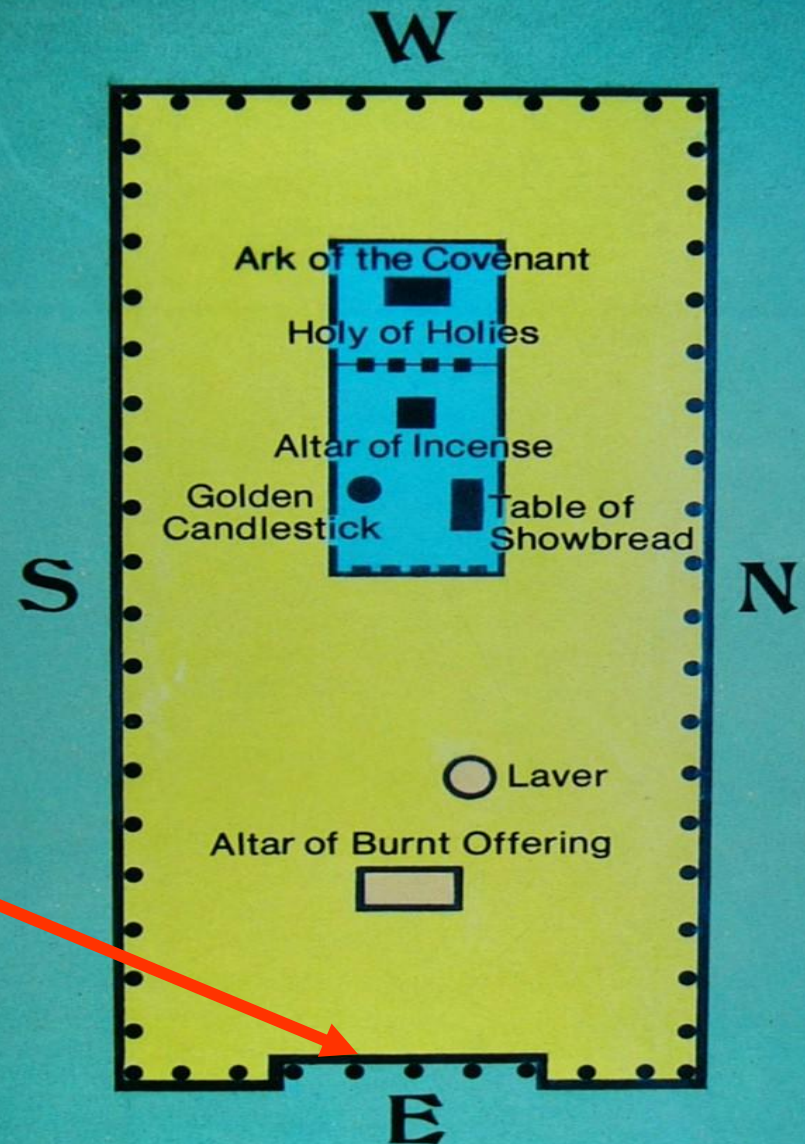


EXODUS 26 THE TABERNACLE

- 3 “ZONES” of holiness
- Holy of Holies...most
- Holy Place...less
- Outer Court...least
- 150 ft. X 75 ft.
- 30 ft. wide gateway
- Always faced EAST

GATEWAY



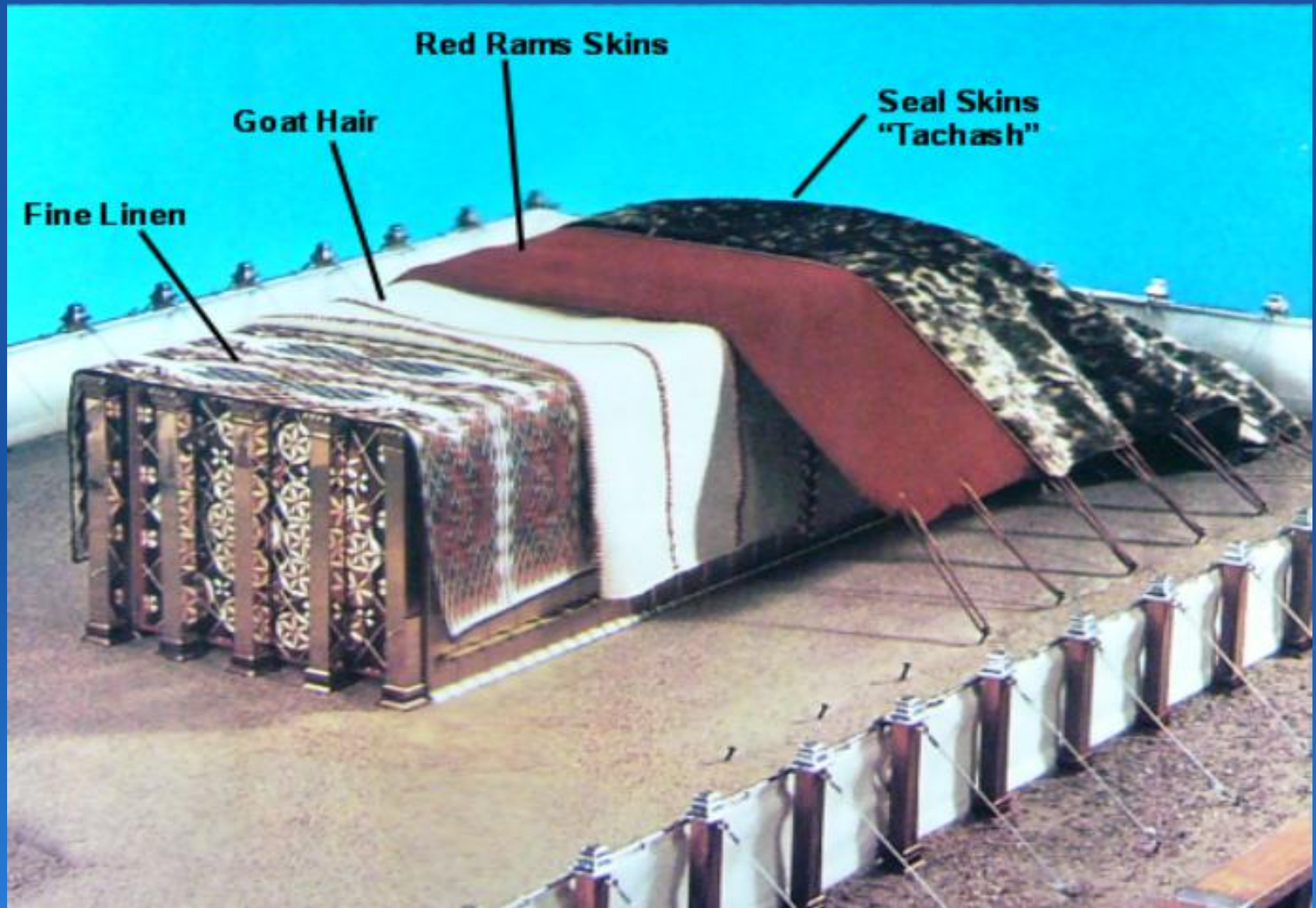
Acacia wood pillar

SANCTUARY COVERING



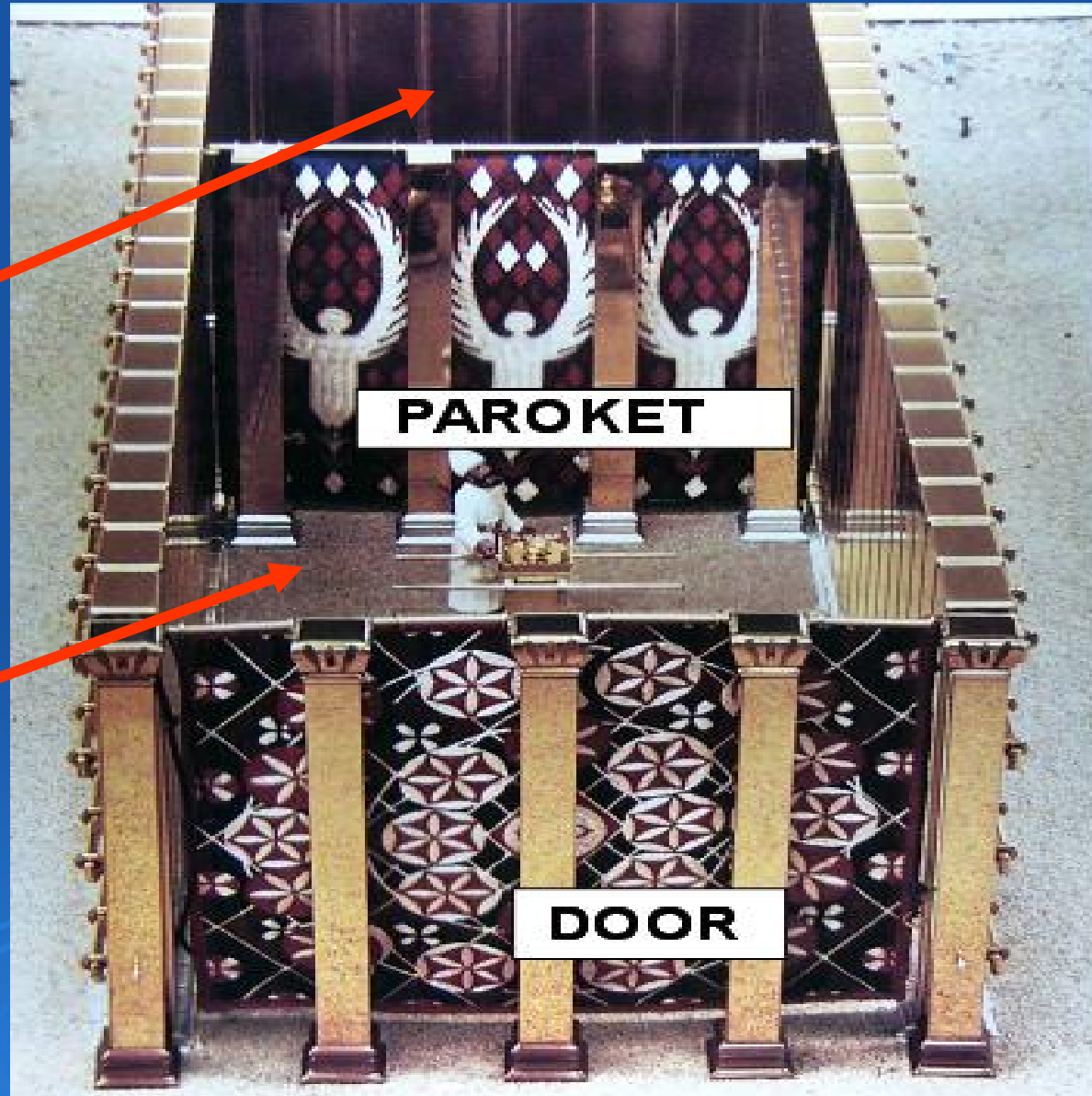
PAROKHET = VEIL

EXODUS 27

THE BRAZEN ALTAR

- Also called:
 - Altar of Sacrifice
 - Altar
 - Altar of Burnt Offering
- Hebrew =
mizbah ha-'olah

Made out of Bronze,
so is called "Brazen"



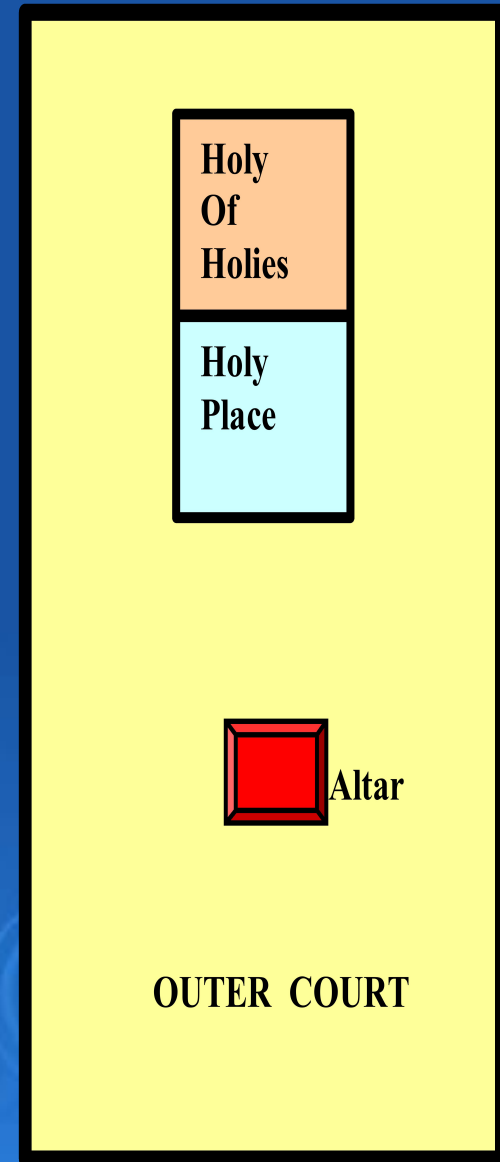
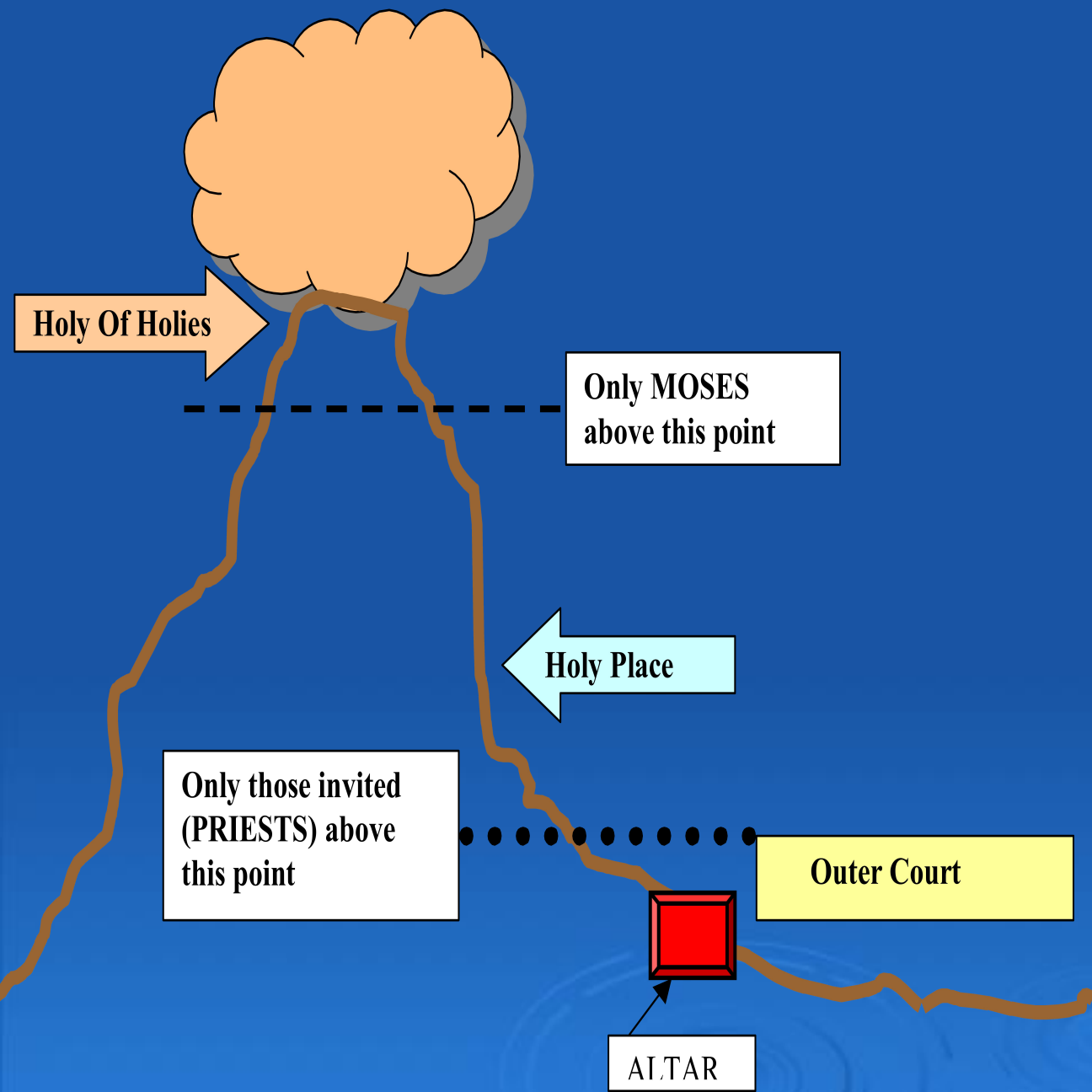
BRAZEN ALTAR



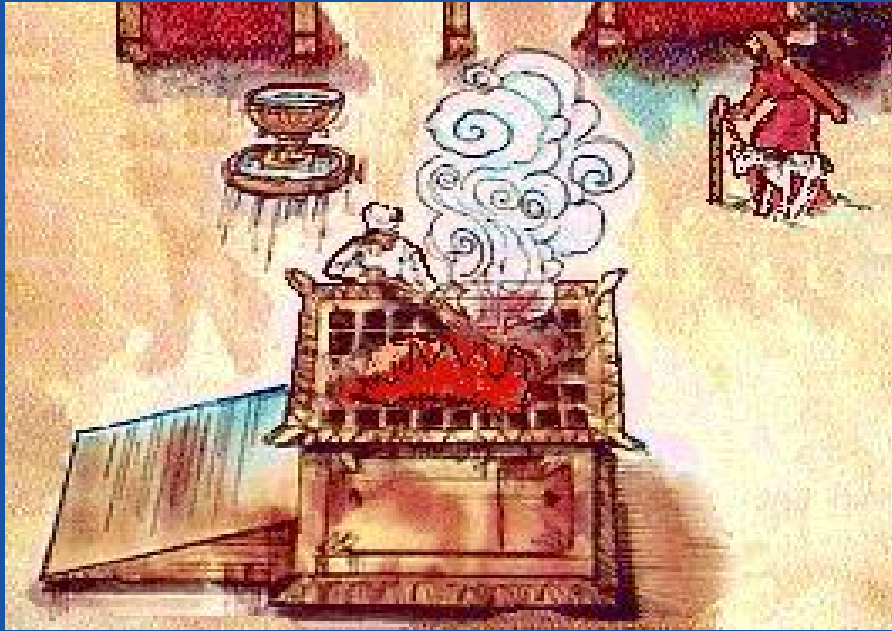
- 7 ½ ft. square
- 5 ft. high
- 4 Horns used to tie animal sacrifices to
- Wooden poles used to carry to new location

THE TABERNACLE



BRAZEN ALTAR = THE CROSS

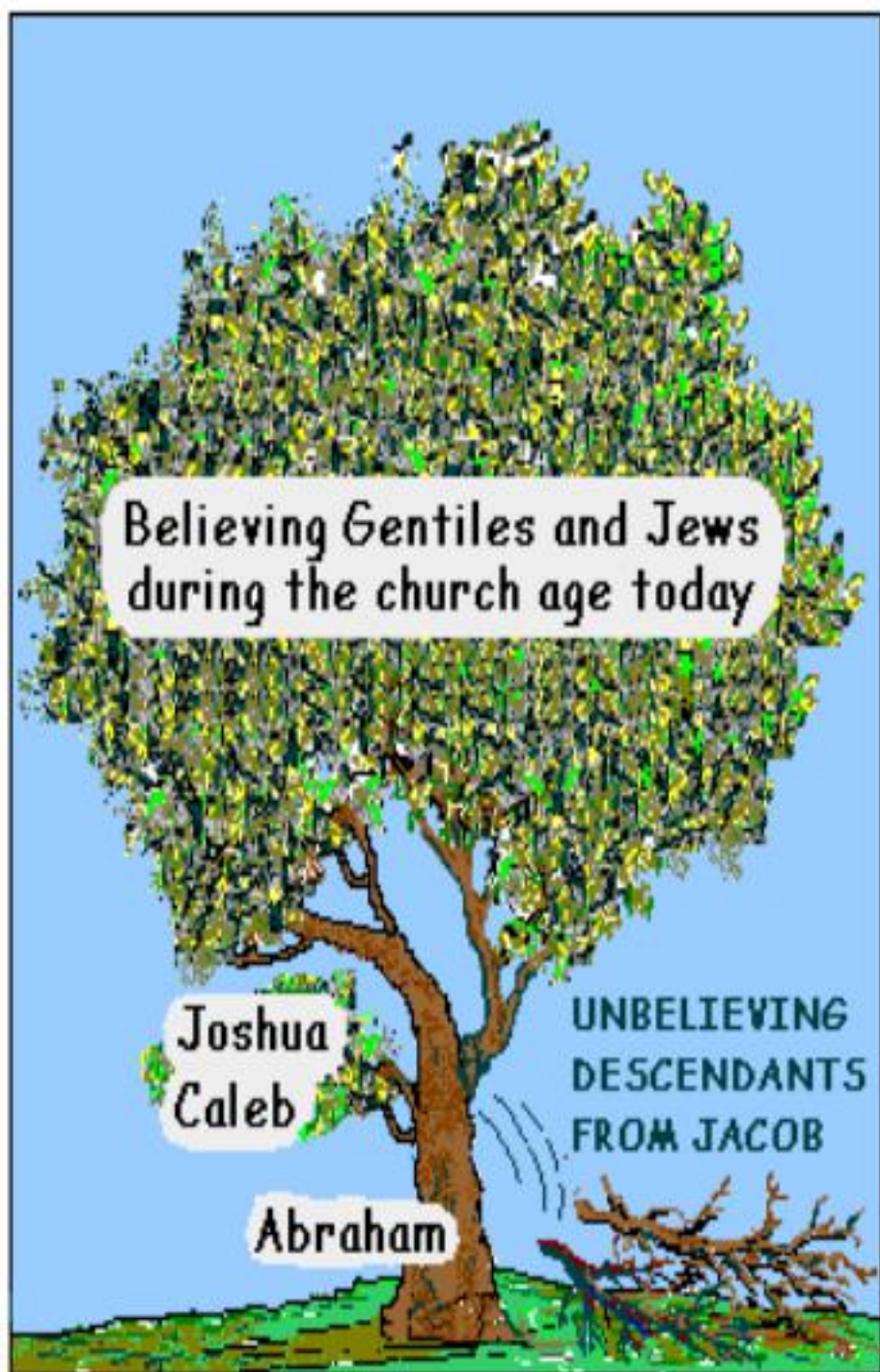


- The Cross is to Christ as the Brazen Altar is to the sacrificial animals
- Sacrificial animals AND Christ had to be:
 - 1) raised up
 - 2) bound to the altar (cross)
 - 3) blood spilled (killed)

IN ORDER TO ATONE FOR SINS

GRAFTED IN

- “Grafted in” is a metaphor meant to explain the spiritual point of view
- Gentiles do NOT become physical Jews when saved!
- Gentiles do NOT have to convert to Judaism as Believers

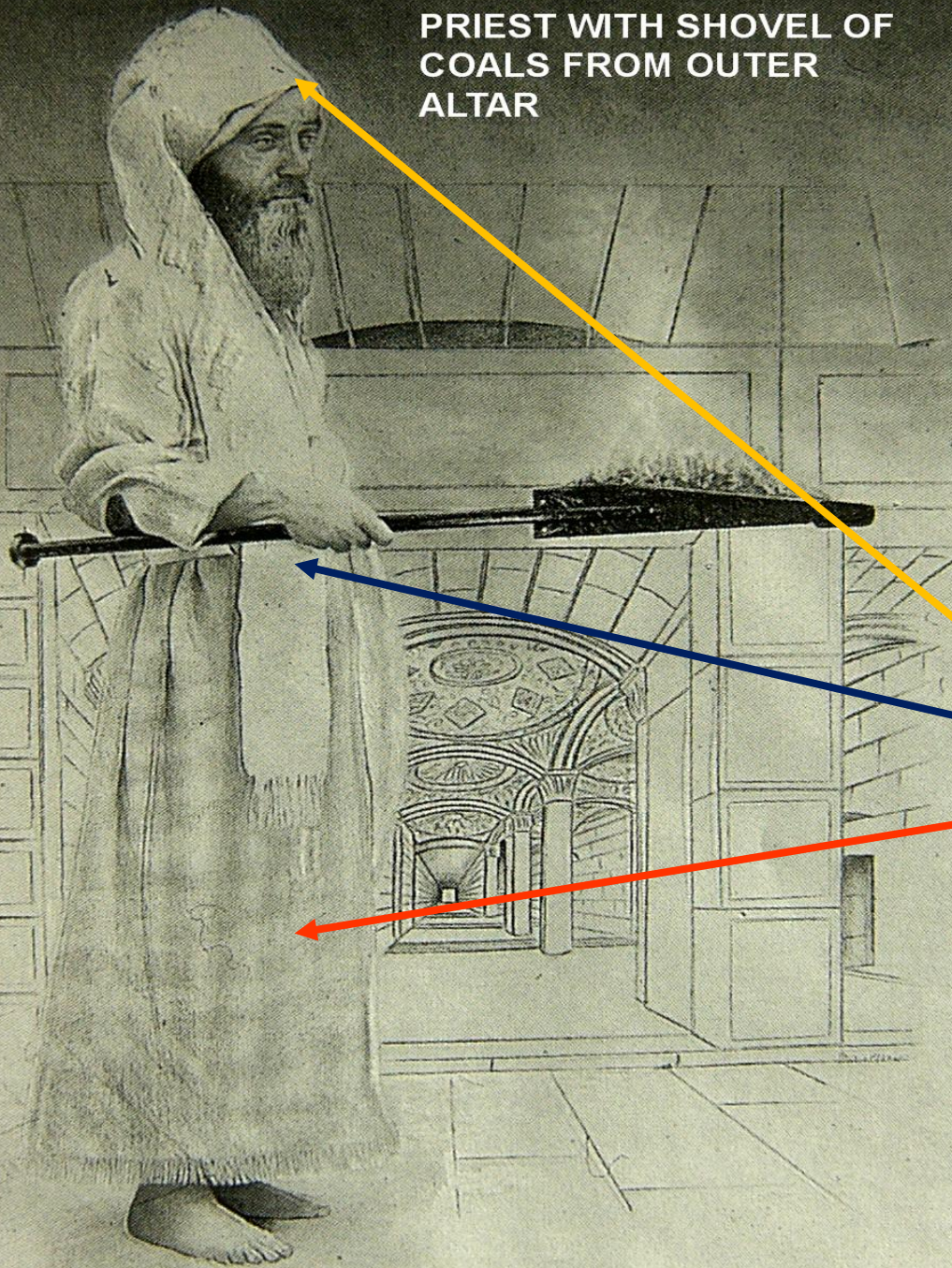
TRIBE OF LEVI

EXODUS 28

PRIEST'S GARMENTS

- Yahweh declares Aaron and his sons Nadav, Avihu, Eleazar, and Ithamar are to be priests to Him
- Priest = Cohen (cohanim is plural)
- Special clothing instructed for the priests
- Typical of Middle East cultures
- A Priesthood was *new* for Israel

PRIEST WITH SHOVEL OF
COALS FROM OUTER
ALTAR



- Uniform for regular Priests
- White linen (byssus)
- Only worn during service at Tabernacle
- Turban (mitre)
- Girdle (belt)
- Tunic
- Breeches (undergarment)
