

THE PRICE OF SIN IS DEATH

- God showed Adam and Eve this principle
- He allowed the blood of innocent animals to pay for men's sins
- The animal blood was a covering for sin, it didn't get rid of it
- Under that disguise, the sin was still there
- Christ would change all that




KAYIN KILLS HEVEL



- > The first RECORDED murder
- The first family was still living in the Land of Eden
- Kayin is banished by God to the EAST
- Nod = wandering, restless
- Kol = anyone, anything, all things
- There were many people on earth by now
- Women were not mentioned due to patriarchal society (male oriented)
- Likely there were more women than men

THE LAND OF NOD




- Nod was east of Eden
- A sign was put onto Kayin
- The verse could read that Kayin WAS a sign
- Nod was to be Kayin's place of sanctuary
- A Sanctuary was a place for a person who killed another to go and be protected

KAYIN IS THE START OF THE LINE OF EVIL PEOPLE

- Evil people are defined as those who turn their backs on God
- > Lamech, 5th generation from Kayin
- Lamech admits and brags about killing a man
- > Havah bears another son, Shet (Seth)
- > Shet means compassion, or granted
- > **Shet** begins the line of good
- Good people are defined as those who "call on the Lord"


GENESIS 5: THE GENEAOLOGY OF SHET

- Adam 130 years old when Shet is born
- Adam was probably still young when Kayin was born
- Adam and Havah were created as physically mature
- A firstborn is a "status" and by Biblical definition is a male
- Almost for sure the number of women were far more than number of men
- Normal for 15 year old girl to give birth



NOACH WAS OF THE LINE OF SHET

- Enoch live 365 days, equal to the days in a solar year
- Noach's father lived 777 years, completeness
- Noach's 3 sons: Ham, Japheth, and Shem
- Noach was 500 years old when his sons were born
- He would have had many other children before these 3 sons




GENESIS CHAPTER 6



- N'filim = offspring of "the Sons of God" and the "the daughters of men"
- Benei Elohim = Sons of God
- N'filim usually translated as "Giants"
- Comes from Greek "gigante", which means fallen, die, cast-down
- A race of tyrants, mutants, evil beings

WERE N'FILIMGIANTS?



- Tradition became that these "fallen angels" took on human form
- Ancient Hebrews see
 N'filim, "Sons of God", as the line of good, the line of Shet
- Daughters of Men seen as the line of evil, the line of Kayin
- Therefore evil and good were put into union and pollution was the result

THE LINE OF KAYIN, AND THE LINE OF SHET WERE TO BE SEPARATE

- God's fundamental principle of good being separated from evil
- God eventually separated Israel away from the world to be a nation set-apart for Him
- N'filim likely represent a "type"
 People who turn themselves over to Evil
- > The source of power for the *N'filim* is Satan
- Types of N'filim: R'phaim, Emim, Anakim, Horim

THE BIBLICAL PRINCIPLE OF TYPES

- > N'filim likely died out in the Great Flood
- Later mention is probably of "types"
- N'filim may have become a general term for evil rulers, or fierce enemy warriors
- > Goliath was from Gath
- Gath was a village ruled by the Anakim (Joshua 11)
- Philistines and Anakim occupied this same territory



- Vs. 3 God's spirit = Ruach or Ruach HaKodesh. It is that attribute of God that deals with man
- The 120 years is not entirely about men's life spans
- It was also that God was giving MANKIND 120 more years to change from their evil ways or be extinguished

ANOTHER FUNDAMENTAL: GOD DOES NOT DESTROY THE FAITHFUL ALONG WITH THE WICKED

- God will NOT pour out His wrath on the righteous
- Yet He does allow bad things to happen to good people
- Allows evil to befall the godly and the godless
- Does not always shelter the godly from persecutions
- But....will NOT shower His divine judgment on the righteous right along with the wicked
- Tribulation = the pouring out of Man's evil upon other men
- God's wrath = God's supernatural calamities
- The Great Flood is the perfect example of this fundamental at work

THE ARK: A GOD-DESIGNED SAFE HAVEN FOR THE FAITHFUL

- > Vs. 9 Noach's story
- > *Tzaddik* = righteous
- > Tammim = whole
- > **Shem** = name
- Melchizedek may have been Shem (he was still living at that time)
- > Shachath = ruined



VS. 13 LIVING BEINGS, NOT SATAN, ARE BLAMED FOR EARTH'S CORRUPTION

- > Basar = flesh
- > CAN mean any living being, animals included
- > Adam is usually used for "man" or "mankind", but it is NOT used here.
- Did God create EVIL? The Hebrews say "yes", but not in the way we might think of it

THE HEBREW VIEW OF GOOD AND EVIL

- 1) Man was created with both a **good** and an **evil** inclination
 - 2) God created evil and good at the Beginning
