REVELING IN IMMORALITY


- 2Kings 15 lays out a murderous history of assassination

- > 4) Vss. 13 16






THE PROBLEM IN TRANSLATING HOSEA 7


- So many lines of text are in disrepair; translating involves educated speculation

OVEN AND BAKING




- Oven was made of fired clay
- Fire built inside the oven
- Burned down until just coals
- Interior walls now hot
- A flattened dinner plate sized lump of bread dough pressed onto an interior wall
- After being half-baked, the bread was turned over
- The fire, the bread preparation, the exact moment the yeast was added (the kneading process), had to be carefully co-ordinated



- Gruber: vs. 5 "The days on which they made our kings sick by means of poison instead of wine. He stretched out his hand to mocking persons"
- Vs. 6 S.M. Paul: "Truly their inwards are like an oven, their hearts like a blazing fire within them"
- Power has become the sole goal of their existence


CORRUPT, POWER-MAD GOVERNMENT LEADERS



- Vs. 7 Personal destruction, then national destruction
- Israel and Judah constantly warring against one another
- Israel takes matters into their own hands
- Israel pays tribute to Assyria for their help
- Corruption baked into our societies

- Ephraim = bread dough
- Nations = yeast
- Leaven (yeast) = sin
- Ephraim is half-baked (literally not-turned)
- Hebrew all consonants, so how it is vocalized adds the vowels and determines the word's meaning
- Israel lost its identity with Yehoveh, then Judah, then with its land
- Their identity as seed of Abraham ended with exile

LOSING OUR IDENTITY





Israel "didn't know" they were losing their identity

Too busy chasing their ambitions and living life

Israel didn't have malice aforethought; they refused to examine themselves in light of God's moral code: The Law of Moses

Vs. 10 "face" means presence

Hosea 5:5 means the same as 7:10



- Israel sees, but doesn't comprehend the grave danger they are in
- They listen, but don't hear the rumblings of catastrophe that is coming
- They flip-flop from one alliance to another
- 2Kings 16:1 9



WOE TO ISRAEL

- Net & birds symbolizes that it is God causing Israel's misfortune
- Vs. 13 Segment 4
- Woe is a word of divine judgment
- Vs. 14 has its context in Hosea and Gomer's marriage and adultery
- Lev usually is heart, but can meant throat
- Israelites slashing themselves, vs. making noises of ecstasy
