

Hosea chapter 10: "Rejection of cult and kingship"

Revelation 17 expands the scope of the identity of the Whore of Babylon to include ALL who pervert their worship of God, not just ancient Ephraim/Israel

Christianity has adopted many pagan and Roman holidays and practices



- God does not accept intense worship if it is not worship as He prescribed it
- Despite their troubles, Israel looked around them and deemed all they were doing to be good
- Only when we accept that His Holy Word is the one and only truth and standard will we correct our course



The style of writing and use of metaphors using poetic license makes meaning harder to extract

Vs. 1, Israel is compared to a vine that is either abundant or ravaged.... which is it?

Thought-for-thought = Israel used all that God had given them not to His glory, but to Baal's credit



Israel believed they had built a perpetual motion machine by building more altars to Baal in thanks for more abundance from their fields and crops

Deuteronomy 29:17 – 20

Lev means heart, but can be used to mean branches

> 2Samuel 18:14 – 15

Chalaq doesn't mean divided, but rather broken-up





THE PROBLEM WITH ICONS

God will destroy un-authorized symbols and images Icons serve no useful purpose before the Lord Vs. 3 God's judgment against Israel's monarchy Fear God = know God Both mean obedient loyalty to God's written moral law code

- To demand a human king was to reject God as king
- ➤ 1Samuel 8:4 9
- Now Israel has no heavenly nor earthly king
- Israel's kings are now powerless before the mighty Assyrian army
- > Vs. 4 "They" = series of Israel's short-lived kings
- God's name was used as the guarantor of covenants and vows
- To use God's name falsely is to use God's name in vain

JUSTICE IS CHOKED-OUT

- A stark contrast between the ideal Israel and the actual Israel of Hosea's era
- Vs. 5 Icons and symbols were counted on for prosperity
- Beth-Aven is a sarcastic insertion in place of Beth-El
- Aven = troubles or wrong-doing

Poisonous weeds in furraws.

IDOLATRY REVEALED



> The Golden Calf had become the centerpiece of Israel's religion Israel no longer knew the Torah Custom and Tradition overrode God's commands "The Glory" = a manifestation of God > Vs. 6 The Calf Gods will be carried away by the enemy Carried away to the god Ashur, not to "Assyria"

SHAME

Ashamed!

> **Boshnah** = shame Boosh = ashamed > Shame = a societal status > Ashamed = embarrassed > Vs. 7 "Foam on water" > Qetseph = twig or splinter The thought is: Israel's kings float aimlessly upon the waters of history



The "sin of Israel" is those shrines they erected

- So much value and trust was placed in them that it was an insult to the Lord
- The many altars and shrines would soon be abandoned and overgrown with weeds and thistles
 A systematic betrayal of God

Mountains "bury us", hills "fall on us"

- ≻ Luke 23:28 30
- A hyperbolic expression of grief and sorrow
- "I wish I had never been born!!"
- Better to die than fall into enemy hands
- Revelation 9:6
