




- Hosea 13:9 11 God is saying He will destroy Israel
- Israel is in full-blown denial
- Israel's only rational response is to plan and prepare
- Since God is against Israel, then God is the only one who can deliver them
- Deuteronomy 33:26 29



BE CAREFUL WHAT YOU ASK FOR

- Israel's government is in chaos
- "So, now, where is your king" the better translation
- > 1Samuel 8:4 20
- Vss. 9 11 God is reminding Israel of the warning He gave to them long ago about kings
- This verse penned when Assyria deposed King Hoshea




- > It was God's anger that gave Israel a mortal king
- God's wrath has brought Israel's monarchy to an end
- First King of Israel was Saul 1030 B.C.
- Last King of Israel was Hoshea 725 B.C.
- David was the only king that seemed to please God, because of the way he ran the government

ISRAEL'S INIQUITY IS SEALED

- > 13:16 OR 14:1 ??
- > Avon = iniquity, worst of the worst sins
- Just as today, evidence was stored and sealed for use at a trial
- > Job 14:17
- The one feeling the pain of childbirth is NOT the child, it is the mother
- Israel feels this "birth" pain because of their sins





- Vs. 14 Terms are often expressions that are rooted in 8th Cent. B.C. Israel culture and language
- Two different interpretations: 1) An expression of hope for Israel, or 2) Israel is left to its fate of judgment
- Deuteronomy 4:26
- Mot and Sheol can be synonymous terms, here they are personified as the powers over the Underworld of Death

2 METAPHORS AS 2 CURSES

- Deuteronomy 28:12 explains the blessings
- Deuteronomy 28:15 explains there will be curses for disobedience
- Deuteronomy 28:23 25 lists the curses
- East wind is a hot, dry destructive wind, which symbolizes Assyria
- Israel's prosperity is in process of passing away







- The Dead Sea Scrolls show that the verse about Samaria is meant to stand alone as a unit of thought
- Chapters and verses were artificially added to our Bibles 1000 years ago by a Christian scholar
- Assyria attacking from the North, Judah from the South
- King Sargon of Assyria aimed his attack at Samaria due to King Hoshea's treachery of refusing to pay the agreed-to tribute that is standard for a vassal king/nation to pay to their master




- Is it sheen-mem (guilt)?



START AT THE BEGINNING!




- Hosea written well before 2Kings
- 2nd Kings is more historical record
- Hosea is more theological
- Assyrian records say that Sargon took captive 27,290 Israelites as slaves
- After 13 chapters of judgment, chapter 14 offers hope



- Vss. 2 & 3 (or 1 & 2) form a prayer for the End Times for the descendants of the Northern Kingdom
- > YLT Hosea 14:1 Turn back, O Israel, unto Jehovah thy God, For thou hast stumbled by thine iniquity.
- All English Bibles say "Lord"... it is actually Yehoveh

- Suvah = turn back, return, or repent
- To "turn back" to God meant only ONE THING! To return to the Torah
- Christ said in Matt. 5 that His followers are to obey the Torah
- To repent means to change our behaviors
- The grace-focused modern Church is unbalanced, and has forgotten obedience and right behavior
