- Just as the Book of Daniel was over-weighted in Yeshua's day, so are Revelation and Joel today
- After putting together the words of the Prophets, still much mystery remains

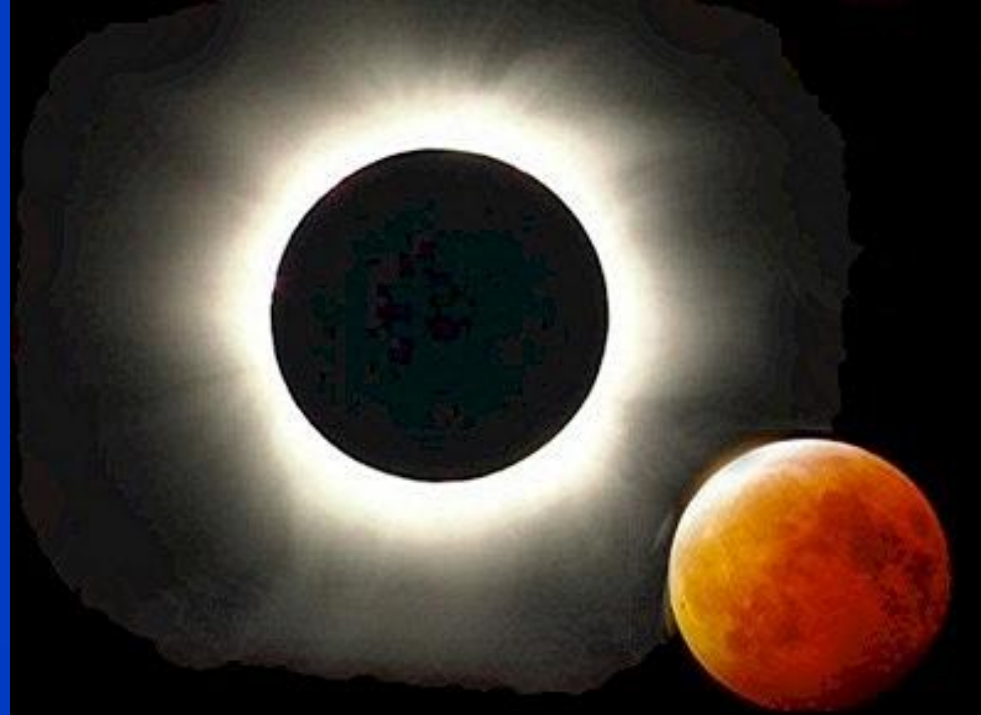
CERTAINTY

- Yeshua WILL return!
- The Day of Yehoveh WILL happen!
- The future Day of Yehoveh WILL be God judging the nations
- The earlier ones were God judging Israel
- Prophecy often envisions multiple fulfillments of the same prophecy at different times in history



MALACHI AND THE END TIMES

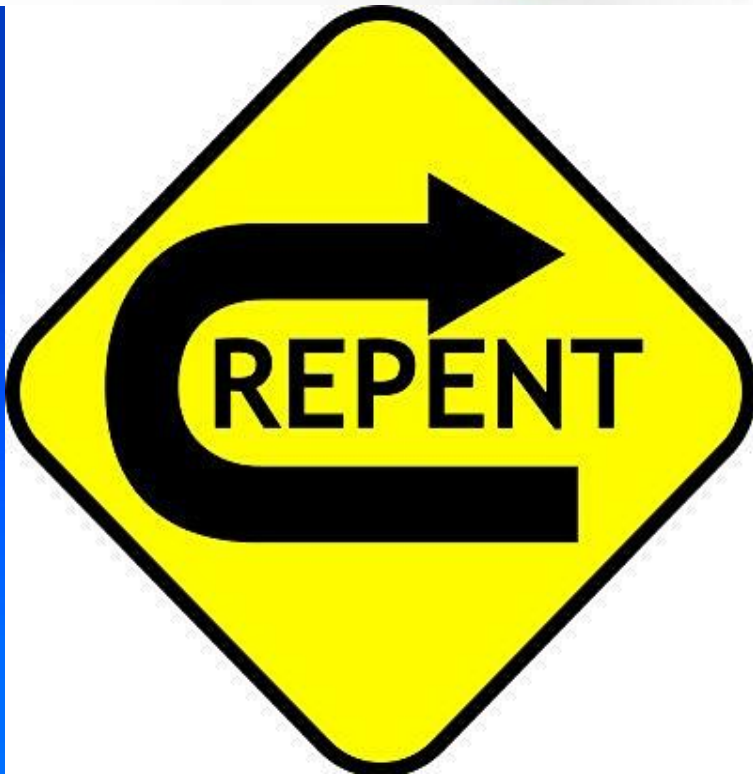
- Joel 2:10, 11 cannot be a human-led invasion
- Humans can't effect the Cosmos
- Malachi 3:1 – 6
- Some of his message has to do with John and Yeshua
- The judgment Malachi describes had to come after Yeshua...and it had to be on the nations



PROCESS OF ELIMINATION



- The passing of history makes prophecy more intelligible to us
- Nothing of prophetic significance happened after 70 A.D. until 1948
- Judgment of Malachi has yet to happen
- Final Day of Yehoveh is a reversal of the previous ones





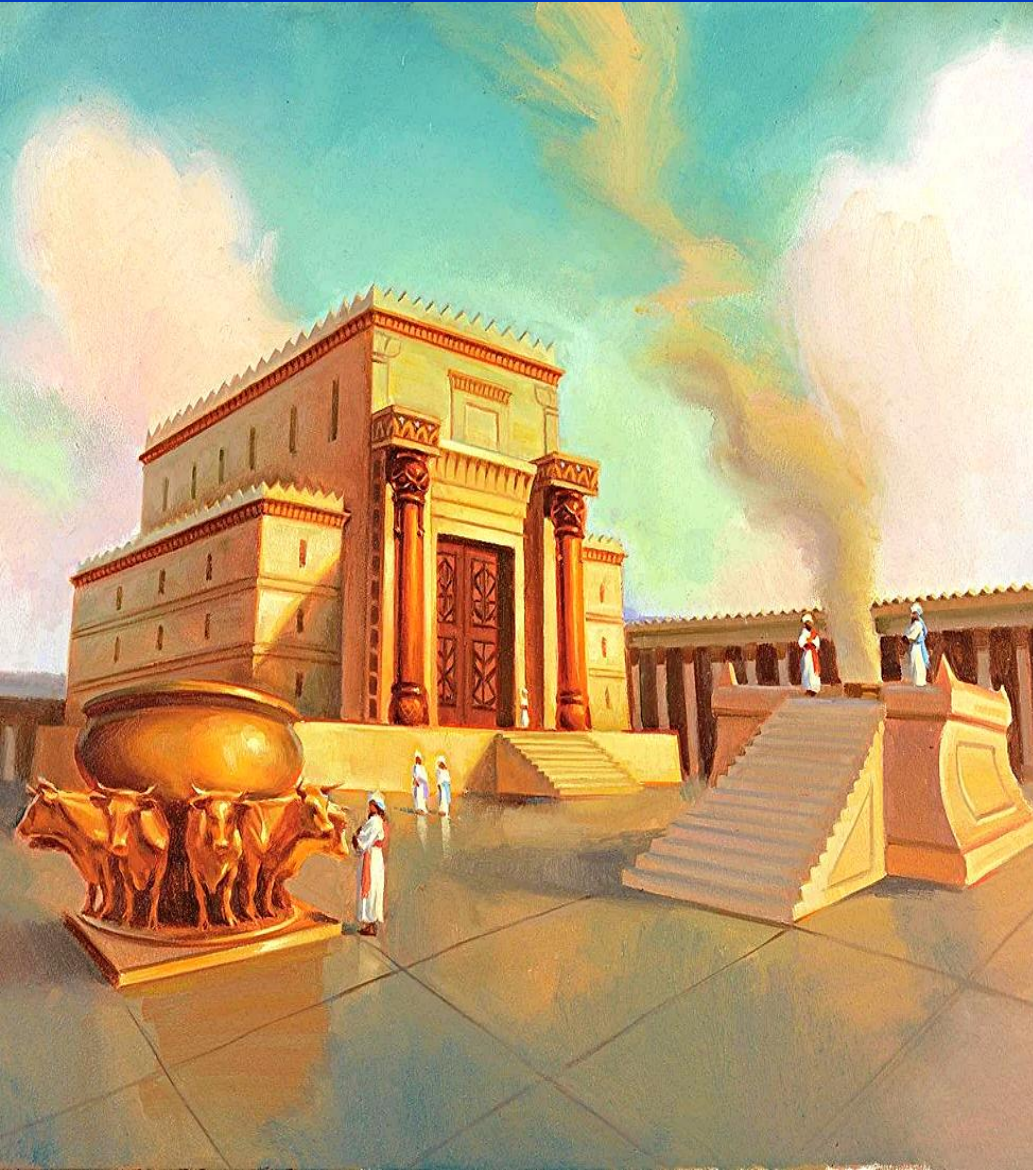
- Fasting, weeping, and mourning are outward signs of a change of heart
- Tearing one's heart and not garments means to begin with a much deeper level of remorse, as opposed to only doing cultural norms mechanically
- Psalm 51:16 - 21

JESUS THE GENIE?

- Vs. 13 For God to “repent of evil” means to change His mind about causing a disaster
- Remorse is not an assurance of forgiveness
- **“The simple step of a courageous individual is to not take part in a lie”**
- PERHAPS He will relent
- Matthew 18:19 - 20



CALL A HOLY MEETING



- Because of the locust invasion, no food can be offered as a sacrifice
- Zephaniah 2:1 – 3
- Elder, children, infants, Bride and Bridegroom are included
- Vs. 17 instructs the Priests to be an intercession for the people
- Foreigners might ask “Where is their God?”



A DIRE EMERGENCY!

- Joel 2:1 -17 summary
- A Day of Yehoveh is coming, will be worse than the locusts
- Returning to God means only 1 thing: returning to the Torah
- Being a Believer does not make us immune to a national judgment
- Revelation 3:5

- Vs. 18 offers a restoration of Israel
- Today Israel is back mostly as a unified nation
- “became jealous for the land” is about a zealous intercession by God
- Leviticus 26:40 – 45
- Wrong minded to demand land be given to the Palestinians
- The people and the land of Israel are inseparable
