


THE CROSS-HANDED BLESSING




- Ephraim and Manasse were Jacob's grandchildren
- Adopted them from Joseph
- Jacob gave the firstborn rights to Ephraim, and not to Reuben
- Ephraim and Judah became the dominant tribes
- Ephraim was conquered and dispersed by Assyria
- Ezekiel 37: The Two Sticks Prophecy

ISRAEL IN EGYPT




- Tribes of Israel go to Egypt about 1800 BC
- Archaeologists and Egyptologists look at history in terms of TIME
- All history before 600 BC is dated according to when certain Egyptian Pharaohs ruled
- Big holes in Egyptian Dynasty timeline
- Bible timeline discarded

PROOF OF HEBREWS IN EGYPT




EGYPT AFTER DEATH OF JOSEPH



- Joseph dies 1700 BC
- Egypt is now two kingdoms
- Semite Pharaohs rule from time of Joseph until about 1600 BC
- Egyptian general overthrows Semite Pharaoh and his government


ISRAEL IS ENSLAVED



- Israel is made the scapegoat for Egypt's problems
- Hebrews can no longer own property
- Egyptian nationals form a menacing army
- Hebrews become the Egyptian work force

MOSHEH (MOSES)

- 1400 B.C.
- Mose Egyptian word that means “born of”
- Mosheh Hebrew means “drawn out”
- Moses KNEW who his real family was, and regularly visited his mother



MOSES STRIKES BACK



- Guard STRUCK a slave, but Moses KILLED the guard
- Moses tried to hide his deed, but there was a witness
- Moses' life of luxury is now over

MOSES FLEES TO MIDIAN




MOSES IN MIDIAN

- Moses becomes a Shepherd
- WHO IS GOD?


THE BURNING BUSH

- Moses 80 years old
- Goes to Mt. Horeb, Mountain of God, later called Mt. Sinai
- Yehoveh confronts Moses
- Moses accepts God's instructions to return to Egypt and rescue the Israelites



MOSES CONFRONTS PHARAOH

- Aharon (Aaron), Moses' brother, becomes spokesman
- Aharon convinces tribal leaders of Moses' mission
- Pharaoh responds by increasing Hebrews' workload

3,000,000 ISRAELITES


- 600,000 MEN bearing arms
- Doesn't count women, children, elderly
- Was sufficient enough size to frighten Egyptian government officials, and jeopardize their work force



PROVISIONS FOR 3 MILLION PEOPLE

- 11,000,000 gallons of water per day
- All the box cars of 2 freight trains, each a mile long.....for food
- Does NOT count for water needs for the herds and flocks





THE GOLDEN CALF

ISRAEL APPROACHES CANAAN



- Israel stayed at Mt. Sinai about 1 year
- 12 spies (1 from each tribe) sent out to spy on Canaanites
- 10 say enemy too strong
- People rebel, God turns them back into the Wilderness

- Moses dies
- Joshua is anointed the new leader of Israel
