
THE ALREADY REDEEMED

- Their salvation history was in grave danger of being reversed
- Direct correlation
 between Judges and the
 Church Age


OUR EVIL INCLINATION REMAINS



- > Redemption does not end our evil inclination (yetzer harah)
- > Israel's (and OUR) delusions entrapped them (US!)
- Believed they could worship BOTH Ba'al <u>and</u>YHWH
- Halloween? Pagan symbols intertwined with Christmas and Easter?
- Judges 2:2 "...you have paid no attention to what I said. What is this you have done?"


JUDGES 2: THE CYCLE OF SIN

 with devotion to
 something else is
 to abandon God




ISRAEL AS A WIFE TO YHWH

- Marriage is a physical tangible way to act out the kind of relationship God wants with His followers
- When a level of unfaithfulness crosses a certain line, it is to ABANDON the marriage
- Hosea 1 children's names
- Yizre'el God sows catastrophe
- Lo-Ruchamah no more pity
- Lo-Ammi no longer God's people



"....the people of Israel did what was evil in YHWH's eyes....."



- Israel did NOT think they had abandoned YHWH
- Our viewpoint is irrelevant next to God's
- It is the Torah that defines sin, holiness, purity, and righteousness
- "Didn't know YHWH" means they CHOSE to ignore His Word and Israel's salvation history


THE NOSTRILS OF THE LORD BURNED



- Vs. 14 "...the 'aph of the Lord burned against Israel.."
- By definition, idolatry meant Israel was offering Burnt Offerings to the Ba'als
- They offered these same offerings to God and He of course found them unacceptable
- In Torah PROPER Burnt Offerings were a sweet aroma to God's nostrils

UNCLEAN OFFERINGS

- We have no authority to declare as good what God says is evil
- At some point God will open His hand and let us go if we are determined enough
- ➤ Romans 1:26 "God has given them up to degrading passions...have exchanged natural sexual relations for unnatural"



5 REASONS FOR ISRAEL'S FALL

- 1) Tribal disunity led to Tabernacle becoming dilapidated, and Ark becoming dissociated from it
- 2) Not removing Canaanites exposed Israel to pagan customs they couldn't resist
- 3) Israel looked to the Canaanite gods to ensure their crops and harvests
- 4) Sacred Sex became part of Israel's worship, as it was in Canaanite worship
- > 5) Syncretism






CONTINUING APOSTASY

- Body of Believers AND modern Israelis are following the same path as the era of the Judges
- Israel ready to give away more land for peace
- Temple Mount complete with Muslim worship centers may be given to Palestinians
- Israel cites "humanitarian" reasons they give aid and comfort to their enemies

PRESSURE ON GOD'S PEOPLE

- Lord raised up a Judge, the Judge would be a savior
- Lachats (OT) = pressure
- Thlipsis (NT) = pressure
- Thlipsis always translated as "tribulation"
- The 2 pressure points on Israel were:
- > 1) social pressure to conform
- 2) coercion from the government to comply with laws and customs




IDENTITY IS BASED ON THE COVENANT

- God is so angry with Israel's idolatry that He refers to them as "ha-goy"
- Goy means gentile
- God is saying "this gentile-like nation (Israel) violates my covenant"
- Nassa = judicial trial
- Canaanites left in Israel's land as a means for proving whether they'll be Torah observant or rebellious
