
REFUSAL TO PARTICIPATE

- Kishon River swelled by a flashflood to help defeat Sisera




ANGEL OF THE LORD



- Meroz is thought to be a town or village
- Malach YHWH = messenger of Yehoveh
- Malach = ANY kind of messenger
- A malach refutes all attempts to worship Him
- Malach YHWH accepts worship

RABBIS SAY THIS MALACH WAS DEBORAH OR BARAK



- Judaism tends to humanize spiritual events
- This is speaking of a manifestation of God
- Shophetim NEVER given the title of "angel of the Lord"
- This Angel of the Lord speaks in the 1st person ("I" or "Me")

YA'EL A GENTILE WOMAN

- Ya'el the wife of Hever the Kenite
- "blessed more than all women" is NOT a literal pronouncement of God elevating Ya'el's status
- Ya'el knew that NOT to help God's people is the same as being against them
- No such thing as neutrality in God's economy
- This was war so Ya'el's actions must be seen in that context



DEBORAH MOCKS SISERA'S MOTHER

- Sisera's mother wonders why her son isn't back from the battle, yet
- She concludes it's because there's so much booty to divide up
- Captured women were often taken home as sex slaves
- Story ends with: "and the land had rest...."

JUDGES CHAPTER 6

- Gideon begins the 2nd half of the period of the Judges
- The 5th cycle of rebellion, apostasy, oppression, deliverance
- After rescue Israel would be true to YHWH, but then in time backslide into idolatry

JOSHUA DIDN'T DRAIN THE SWAMP


- The remaining alligators (Canaanites) thrived and became pests
- Seems like no matter how many cycles of foolishness of Israel and the Church we'll keep doing the same things!!
- Next cycle begins with the words: "..the people did what was evil in God's eyes...."





EVIL MORE DECEPTIVE THAN OVERT

- Doing what is right in our own eyes IS EVIL!!
- Israel did NOT set out to do evil
- Israel would DENY they were committing sin and idolatry
- Prophets knew they would suffer at the hands of the people God was accusing






MIDIAN


- Midian a semi-nomadic tribe
- Related to Israel through Abraham
- Midian oppressed Israel for 7 years before God acted
- Midian, Amalek, and "children of the east" were allies
- Only wanted the produce, not to conquer the land
- Islamic law is a law of nomads and predators


NOMADS CAME ON CAMELS

- In the 8th year the invaders came and set up tent camps
- Took all the produce and flocks
- Camels were the weapons platform of Ishmael, the Arabs
- Took over 7 years for Israel to finally cry out to God for His help









FEAR WAS THE PROBLEM

- An unnamed prophet rebukes God's people
- The Lord wanted His people to know that HE brought this calamity on them as punishment
- Fear causes us to compromise and appease!
- The rise of Islam has the world in fear
- The world's leaders say that showing tolerance for Muslims and recognizing Allah is the answer
