#### LEVITICUS 16 YOM KIPPUR




- Scripture is NOT doctrine and doctrine is NOT Holy Scripture!
- How do Christians discovering their Hebrew faith roots deal with TRADITION?
- Biblical dietary laws
   (Lev.11 & Deut.14) are less
   than 3 pages total
- Jewish Tradition about diet is thousands of pages

#### SEPARATING JEWISH AND CHRISTIAN TRADITION FROM THE WORD OF GOD


- We do NOT want to throw the baby out with the bathwater!
- Many "traditions" are useful, meaningful, beautiful, and full of truth....others are NOT
- No need to make praise and worship bland and sterile
- Few Hebrew commentators directly addressed Lev.16, most discussed <u>the Traditions</u> about Yom Kippur



#### YOM KIPPUR PRACITICES CHANGED DRAMATICALLY AFTER 70 AD



- > 70 AD Temple destroyed, never rebuilt to this day
- > Temple is REQUIRED for all the rituals of Leviticus
- How to observe feasts, holy days, purification rites after the Temple was gone?
- Not all things were meant to be continued. Yeshua fulfilled many of the Temple rituals
- > BELIEVERS ARE TO DISTINGUISH BETWEEN THE CONSECRATED AND THE MERELY COMMENDABLE



# THE DAY OF ATONEMENT

- > Two purposes:
- 1) Purify the Tabernacle (and later the Temple
- 2) Purify the priests and the common Israelites
- > REASON:
- If Yehoveh's earthly dwelling place was defiled, He could not be present there

### HOW DID THE TABERNACLE BECOME DEFILED?

- > A Priest not properly performing his duties
- Unclean food accidentally being used
- Someone touching a dead body enters the grounds
- Uncleanness, to some degree, is UNAVOIDABLE!
- Uncleanness is a state that can be entered with NO moral failure on the part of the person (no longer so for Believers)
- No watertight connection between avoiding sin and avoiding impurity

# APPROACHING GOD IS DANGEROUS

- Yehoveh will not tolerate a violation of His holiness
- In Lev. 16, Aaron's sons deaths were very recent
- God explains to Moses in vs. 2 how Aaron can avoid the same fate
- High Priest may only enter when God says he can
- ONLY 1 day per year, on Yom Kippur



# AARON ENTERS THE HOLY OF HOLIES



- Young bull for Hatta'at offering
- Ram for 'Olah offering
- High Priest was to wear plain white linen garments inside the Holy of Holies
- High Priest was the holiest man in Israel, but before God his holiness was as nothing
- NAS Revelation 19:8 And it was given to her to clothe herself in fine linen, bright and clean; for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.



# THE SCAPEGOAT RITUAL

- 2 male goats
- Lots are cast to choose the goats' fates
- One lot "for Yehoveh", and the other lot "for Azazel"
- The word "scapegoat" is usually substituted for Azazel in most translations




#### **AZAZEL**

- Most interpretations:
  - 1) means "complete destruction"
  - 2) "rocky precipice" VERY unlikely!
- In book of Enoch,Azazel is a demon (mythology)
- Azazel might represent Satan


# GOAT FOR AZAZEL <u>NOT</u> TO BE RITUALLY SLAUGHTERED

Goat for Yehoveh WILL be ritually killed

Goat for Azazel is expected to die in the Wilderness (desert)



- Hot coals taken for Altar of Burnt Offering
- Incense added
- Kapporet = Mercy Seat
- Smoke:
  - 1) Obscures God so that Aaron does not look upon Him and die
  - 2) Connected to cloud which guided Israel
- Smoke was PROTECTION for Aaron
- Blood sprinkled on Kapporet, eastward (front of Mercy Seat)
- Bull's blood (for Aaron), and Goat's blood for all Israel






- Next, the Altar or Burnt Offering is cleansed with the Bull's and Goat's blood
- High Priest lays hands on "scapegoat's" head
- Transfers sins from all Israel onto the goat
- Goat sent out into wilderness (sins sent far away)
- Wilderness often considered a place of evil....of cast-out demons being sent into the dry Wilderness

#### **MORE ON AZAZEL**

- Azazel thought to be a demon ruler of the Wilderness
- Two goats: One set-apart for holiness (for God), and the other will be a DEPOSITORY for Israel's sin and uncleanness
- Scapegoat loaded up with evil, and sent BACK to it's source....the Evil One
- Azazel in book of Enoch was a fallen angel, given jurisdiction over sorcery and magic. His domain was the desert wilderness. MYTH!!
- God mocking Satan?

Verses 25 – 28: Only specified parts of the Hatta'at sacrifices are to be burnt-up on the Altar. Remainder to be taken OUTSIDE THE CAMP and destroyed. This act is GETTING RID of that which is not for God. That which is not for God will burn.



## DAY OF ATONEMENT OBSERVANCES CHANGED

- > 10<sup>th</sup> Day of the 7<sup>th</sup> Month of the Year
- Yom Kippur a super-Shabbat
- NOT a 7<sup>th</sup> day Shabbat, rather a special one
- Afflict one's self = deprive, Fasting
- Tradition makes it a day of abstaining
- Was made for Israelite and those who sojourn with Israel
- This is a "law for the ages" Permanent



#### TRADITIONS OF YOM KIPPUR SINCE DESTRUCTION OF TEMPLE



- God judges a person on Yom Kippur
- 10 days of penitence begins on Rosh Hashanah
- Tallit can be worn at EVENING service (normally only mornings)
- No longer a NATIONAL, but an INDIVIDUAL purpose
- Kapparot
- Belief that today prayer, repentance and good deeds atone
- Persons own death atones for grave sins
- Hebrews 9 about Yom Kippur
