



- We don't know when Yeshua moved from Nazareth to Capernaum
- At vs. 35 He has decided to travel around Galilee to synagogues and villages to declare the Good News
- In this case, the "Good News" is not Salvation; it is about the arrival of the Kingdom of Heaven
- This idea has not yet been taught even to His disciples

- Why has Yeshua avoided revealing who He is?
- The basic fundamentals must be learned first
- Yeshua knew the Jewish people were not properly prepared to know who He is
- Christ was in process of re-teaching what the people thought they knew

HARVEST: END OF A CYCLE




- The Harvest is the next to the last step
- ➤ Rev. 14:14 16
- After the harvest comes the winnowing
- We must <u>not</u> read: "Harvesting only Christians"
- The harvest is of the good and the bad
- P'shat: Yeshua is speaking of the here and now, so the harvest was of Jews

- Remez: Yeshua was also speaking of a 2nd Latter Days
- Alluding to the fullest and final harvest, including the final judgment
- The harvest is of all humans, alive and who have ever lived
- > Rev. 20:11 13

THE HARVEST OF THE END TIMES






- Matthew lists 12 Disciples along with their names
- Why 12? It is symbolic of the 12 tribes of Israel
- ➤ Matt. 19:27 28 12 Disciples judge the 12 tribes
- > At the moment, Israel was Christ's target
- 10 of the tribes called "lost" weren't so lost to the Jews of the 1st century


- The 10 "lost" tribes will return to the Holy Land and reunite with the 2 tribes (Judah and Benjamin)
- This End Times prophecy was well known to the Jews of the 1st century
- ➤ Ezekiel 36:22 27
- ➤ Ezekiel 37:15 22
- 3 signals for the entry into the 2nd Latter Days
- > 1) rebirth of Israel 1948
- > 2) Jerusalem 1967
- > 3) 10 tribes underway

THE 12 TRIBES RECONSTITUTED







- 12 Disciples given authority to do miracles, including raising the dead
- Miracles: a surprising and welcome event that is not explicable by natural or scientific laws..... The work of a divine agency.....
- Many even within Christianity doubt the miracles listed in the Bible, or the possibility of any miracles at all
- Supernatural = something that happens outside of the ability of the natural Universe to cause them



- Old assumptions about how our Universe operates are being found as incorrect
- Quantum physics is defying logic and rationality as we know it
- Quantum theory deals not with what an object IS, but rather a range of probabilities of what it could become







THE NEED FOR AN OBSERVER

- Experiments are proving that time and space may not be tangible things but rather only constructs of the observer's mind
- Experiments are proving that without an observer, a probability wave never becomes a tangible object
- Our Universe literally doesn't become real and tangible without a conscious, sentient observer..... an intelligent being to see it!



- Experiments prove that one particle of a "twin" knows what the other twin is doing.... And can affect it!
- Distance doesn't matter. It takes ZERO time for the state of one particle to affect a change to the other
