





John the Baptist

- The issue becomes the peoples' and cities' response to Yeshua
- > The response is 2 part:
- 1) Individuals
- 2) Corporate/community
- Similar to Abraham and Sodom

- Yeshua is depicted in the Gospel as the embodiment of Wisdom
- In Jewish thought,
 Wisdom took on a form
- → Job 28:12 28
- Wisdom of Sirach
- Apocrypha a separate section of the Bible, no longer in Protestant Bibles
- Sirach written 180 B.C.
- A highly valued book among Jews in Jesus's day



- Jesus knew the Wisdom of Sirach as it was commonly taught within Jewish culture
- The words about Wisdom must be left in their Jewish cultural context or we risk making unsound doctrines
- The Wisdom of Sirach chapter 1:1
- Yeshua identifies Himself as the divine form of Wisdom
- Matthew writes with this understanding in mind


YESHUA ISA.... PROPHET Like MOSES



- The connection between Christ and Moses has always been a struggle for Christianity
- ➤ Exodus 33:12 13
- Meekness is ascribed to Moses in the Torah
- "Yoke" is a common Jewish description of how one is linked to the Torah
- Exodus 33:14 "....set your mind at rest...."

WOE! To.....

- Christ condemns 3 cities to destruction
- The reason: He had done many miracles there and they didn't respond with trust
- Miracles have not proved to lead people to Christ!
- Some disagreement over which ruin is Bethsaida
- Tzor and Tzidon had become like saying Sodom and Gomorrah




THE ISSUE IS REPENTANCE



- Yeshua says if He did miracles in the 2 gentile cities, they would have repented and mourned
- Korazin and Bethsaida will be judged guilty on Judgment Day as unrepentant sinners
- The residents of the 2 Jewish cities thought of themselves as righteous, but those of the 2 gentile cities would not have
- Dual Covenant = Yeshua not needed for salvation for Jews
- Yeshua says that we must trust in Him... Jew or gentile

- Jews want a Messiah; just not the gentile version
- Crusades, Inquisition and the Holocaust were Christian-led against Jews.... not easily forgotten
- The Church must repent, truly love Jews and Israel, and acknowledge our wrong-doing
- This will only happen one Believer at a time
- Christ had to address the wrong doctrine of the Jews before they could know who He truly was

SAVED ONLY BY THE HISTORICAL JESUS!


- The Jesus of the mainstream Church is usually not the historical Jesus
- Knowing the God of Israel is a given; it's knowing His Son that is the issue
- What did Yeshua expect the Jews to trust Him as?







- Capernaum would be sent down to She'ol
- > She'ol = the grave Hades = Greek netherworld
- Vs. 25 is a prayer of Thanksgiving that extols The Father as "Lord of Heaven and Earth"
- Christ is The Father's "agent" that is sent to do The Father's will





"THESE THINGS" ARE HIDDEN

- "These things" are what Jesus was revealing about the Latter Days
- 2 Latter Days, but only 1 End Times
- The Father is hiding revelation from "the wise and understanding"
- Isaiah 29:4 1Cor.1:19
- "The wise and understanding" was a sarcastic term for the Scribes and Pharisees
- Nepioi = babes, the simple

- In God's economy the weak and simple are His elect
- > Job 28:28
- The line of non-spiritual, absent-of-God Bible commentators began after the Enlightenment
- A common thread is that the Bible is but ancient Jewish literature and myth, no different from many others
- No true wisdom or knowledge is attained without trust in God
