

- A label defines people, institutions, things and events, and more with a simple word
- Labels, like Liberal and Conservative, don't always mean the same thing to each person
- "The Church" is a label and different people define it various ways
- A thing called "The Church" does not exist in the New Testament
- Ekklesia = assembly

WHAT IS THE


- > 1) A building 2) any group of religious people
 - 3) A public worship service 4) The official governing body
 - 5) The entire body of Christians as a whole
- What it really means is GENTILES practicing a GENTILE created religion called Christianity
- "The Church" has shunned its Hebrew foundations and made Jewish membership (almost) impossible

WHAT IS A CHRISTIAN?

- > A "Christian" is
 - 1) a gentile 2) a member of The Church
 - 3) A follower of Christ
- The mainstream Church has re-made Yeshua into a gentile or a generic man
- Many Bible scholars don't believe in God; the Bible is merely their chosen field of study
- While their expertise in languages and history can be great, their conclusions about meanings can be dubious


ANOTHER FEEDING MIRACLE

- Yeshua at first refused to help a gentile woman because she wasn't part of Israel
- After her persistence He healed her daughter
- Most Bible scholars do not believe that this 2nd feeding happened as they see it as redundant
- Mark gives us a reason why a 2nd feeding miracle made sense



- ➤ Mark 6:51 52
- Disciples being unprepared for Jesus' walking on water is because they didn't understand about the 1st feeding
- Yeshua says there were 2 feedings
- ➤ Matthew 16:8 10
- Some Bible scholars
 see Christ's actions as
 acting out a future End
 Times prophesy







THE EUCHARIST



- Some Bible commentators see the feeding as pointing towards the establishment of the Eucharist
- Eucharist is a Roman Church Sacrament built around Communion
- ▶ Isaiah 2:1 3
- The only real commonality between Isaiah and Matthew is the hill!
- At the feeding it was bread and fish, not bread and wine



- > The crowds were coming for the *Tzadik* to heal them
- > They had no view of Jesus as Messiah at this point
- There was no distinction between everyday life and spiritual life in that era (and there shouldn't be now!)
- The healed people said a b'rakhah to the God of Israel




OPPORTUNITY OF A LIFETIME

- 1st feeding, the crowds were there 1 day
- > 2nd feeding, 3 days
- Probably no significance in the #3 since it was expressed only in days, and not days <u>and</u> nights
- Eucharisteo =
 give thanks
- The blessing over the bread was standard for all Jews and not a special event

"Feed My sheep"

- Important that we see that again it was the disciples' job to hand out the food
- > John 21:17
- Feeding the sheep occurs on 2 levels:
 1) handing out literal food, and
 2) teaching God's Word as spiritual food
- 12 often symbolic of the whole house of Israel
- 7 the Ideal Number, wholeness, completion



7 and 12

WHERE IS MAGADAN?



- 4000 men plus women and children likely added up to around 8000 people in the crowd
- Yeshua moves on to Magadan
- Many theories on what or where that is
- Mark 8:10 calls it Dalmanuta (Roman?)
- Last verse of ch.15 sets up the first verse of ch.16
