

NUMBERS 5: WOMAN ACCUSED OF ADULTERY

- The woman is suspected but does NOT confess
- > Trial by God
- This is different from the Leviticus law of the woman who is caught and confesses
- Husband bring wife to the priest at the Tabernacle
- Oath is written on a scroll and washed off into a cup of "holy water" (living water)
- Dust from the Tabernacle floor is added
- Woman drinks and what happens in the future indicates her guilt or innocence



JOHN 8: WOMAN CAUGHT IN ADULTERY

- Story must be taken in context of Torah
- No admission of woman as to her guilt
- Goal was to discredit Jesus
- This passage is said to show that:
- > 1) Yeshua is all merciful
- 2) sinners have no right to judge anyone else




ODDITIES ABOUT THIS STORY




- Only question for Yeshua is to confirm her punishment
- Standard Christian interpretation:
- 1) Yeshua says that unless the men are sinfree they have no right to accuse or punish
- 2) Yeshua ignores the crime, let's her off the hook, and says just don't sin anymore
- This story has routinely been removed and added back in over the centuries

WHERE'S THE CONFESSION OF FAITH?

- > The subject of faith never came up
- No implication that the woman even knew who Yeshua was
- Adultery is a God-ordained capital offense
- EX. 20: 13 "Do not commit murder, do not commit adultery"
- > LEV.20:10 "...adulteress must be put to death"
- Implication is that Jesus simply dismisses crime and violations of Torah
- The Jesus Pattern is that He forgives the spiritual consequences NOT the earthly




LET HE WHO IS WITHOUT SIN CAST THE FIRST STONE



- If only a sinless person can accuse another or be a witness or punish another, all justice systems would break down
- Unlikely the standard interpretation of this story is correct
- Were the accusers being truthful? Perhaps NOT.


THE WITNESSES BEGIN THE STONING




- Witnesses were the 1st to throw the stones
- Reason was as a deterrent to false or frivolous testimony
- A false witness participating in an unjust execution was a murderer
- Yeshua told the men to go ahead and stone her, UNLESS they were participating in sin
- > The sin was false witness

SHE SHOULD HAVE BEEN TAKEN DIRECTLY TO THE PRIESTS

- Without confession, she should have had the water-ordeal ritual
- Water ordeal was still being practiced in Jesus' day
- Mishnah, Sotah 9, waterordeal outlawed just before 70AD
- Reason: it was misused by men who wanted to be rid of their wives





JESUS WRITING IN THE DUST

- Some inventive, but wrong, conclusions
- 3 ingredients of water concoction: Holy Water, dust, ink of letters of oath
- Holy Water = Living Water
- Dust taken from Temple floor because it was made holy by God's presence
- Ink: God's name was part of written oath
- A Biblical oath, by definition, contained God's name


NUMBERS 5 AND JOHN 8 ARE CONNECTED




- All elements of the Num 5 law are in John 8
- Woman brought before God and priest (Yeshua)
- Brought to the Temple
- Writing, in "holy" dust, because the very ground He stood on He made holy
- Probably wrote YHWH (Yehoveh)
- Yeshua was fulfilling the original Torah law on adultery

PHARISEES AND RABBIS BARELY KNEW THE REAL TORAH

- Had long ago given up Torah for Tradition
- Modern Church calls teaching of doctrines, "Bible teaching"
- Num 5:29 "... the priest shall apply all the law to her..."
- Since the law of Leviticus (for the proven adultery) did not apply, Jesus applied the Numbers 5 law of suspected adultery





DEATH BY STONING

- He who is without sin cast the first stone
- NAS Deuteronomy 17:7 "The hand of the witnesses shall be first against him to put him to death, and afterward the hand of all the people..."
- Witnesses had to cast the first stone
- No one stepped forward
- Therefore Jesus declared she could not be condemned

LAW OF ADULTERY ASSUMES ONE PARTNER WAS FAITHFUL

- "IF the man is clear of sin, THEN the woman shall suffer her guilt"
- Hosea 4:14 "... I won't punish your daughters..... Because the men are themselves going off whoring....."
- Marriage is God's way of demonstrating His relationship with Man
- The same effects of adultery on a marriage, occur with unfaithfulness to God
- If both parties in a marriage are unfaithful, adultery loses its meaning
- Unfaithfulness destroys the marriage dynamic
