


RUEBEN AND GAD WANT TO SETTLE IN MOAB

- Leadership council agrees to request
- Land is on east side of the Jordan (Trans-Jordan)
- War with Midian was NOT about gaining territory
- Israel should have defeated Moab and then moved on
- Moses wanted ALL the tribes to live within the Promised Land

JACOB'S BLESSINGS FORETOLD THIS EVENT

- Reuben and Gad wanted the territory for pasture
- Reuben was "unstable as water", lacked moral strength
- Chose unwisely to stay OUT of the Promised Land
- Gad's prophetic blessing was as a military force
- Rueben and Gad were part of the same division of Israel (camped on the south side of the Tabernacle)
- In God's providence Gad and Reuben provided a buffer between Israel and it's enemies from the east

THE 2 ½ TRIBES

- About ½ of the tribe of Manasseh also decide to stay out of the Promised Land
- This split undoubtedly was to allow for a peaceful resolution to a serious disagreement
- ➤ The other ½ of the tribe of Manasseh moved into Canaan
- It took many years before the boundaries firmed, but they still changed regularly over time

2 ½ TRIBES REBUILT SEVERAL MOABITE CITIES TO LIVE IN THEM

- City names were changed from Moabite names to Hebrew names
- Cities usually rebuilt rather new ones built elsewhere
- Building material was mostly the stones from the previous city
- Tel = a mound that consists of multiple layers of civilizations



NUMBERS 33: THE EXODUS TRAVELOGUE

- Did Israel leave Egypt on Passover?
- ➤ Technically, they left on the 1st day of Unleavened Bread (Nisan 15)
- Passover and Unleavened Bread became fused into one event
- Whole thing eventually called either Passover OR Unleavened Bread out of convenience

Egyptian Passover a bit different than all future Passovers

In Egypt Passover lamb KILLED on the 14th, but EATEN on the

15th of Nisan

Hebrew day changes at SUNSET; so the day CHANGED between the killing of the lamb and the eating of the lamb

Lord did not kill the Firstborns until about Midnight, which would have been Nisan 15th, the 1st day of Matza

THE PASSOVER PROBLEM

- Church presents it slightly off mark because:
- A) Egyptian Passover different than future ones
- B) Earlier Passover got modified in Deuteronomy, and later by Tradition
- C) The technical Scriptural definitions are one thing, but how they are commonly spoken of is another
- D) Several separate Jewish Traditions about how to do Passover were established:
- 1) Jews living in Judea
- 2) Jews living in Samaria
- 3) Jews living in Galilee
- 4) Jews living in the Diaspora

42 STATIONS

- Began journey from Ra'amses on 15th of Nisan
- Only one other date given, death of Aaron 1st day of the 5th month in the 40th year
- Listing of stations in Num 33 does NOT match previous biblical listings
- At the least, these 42 stations are where something significant happened

MOST OF THE 42 STATIONS ARE UNKNOWN TO US




- Most maps showing the route and the stations are too faulty to take seriously
- No archaeological evidence to support the Traditional Mt. Sinai
- Mt. Sinai probably in Arabia, in Midian

CANAAN TO BE EMPTIED

- Israel to destroy everything that has to do with Canaan's false gods
- NO Canaanite people are to remain in the Promised Land
- Genocide is NOT being ordered
- They are to DRIVE OUT the people, but kill those who stay and battle
- Inherent instruction is that those who will join Israel and forsake their old allegiances can remain







DIVISION OF THE LAND

- Only 9 ½ tribes are discussed because the other 2 ½ already have their land
- "....but if you do NOT drive out the inhabitants.....they shall trouble you.....as I plan to do to them, I will do to YOU...."
- Israel has NEVER heeded this warning to this day
- Joshua did NOT do as God told him
- Israel even allows Muslims to control the Temple Mount,

THE WEST BANK IS THE PROMISED LAND!

- ➤ The 9 ½ tribes settled on the WEST BANK of the Jordan
- The trouble Israel currently faces is largely due to its cavalier attitude about the land God set apart exclusively for their use
