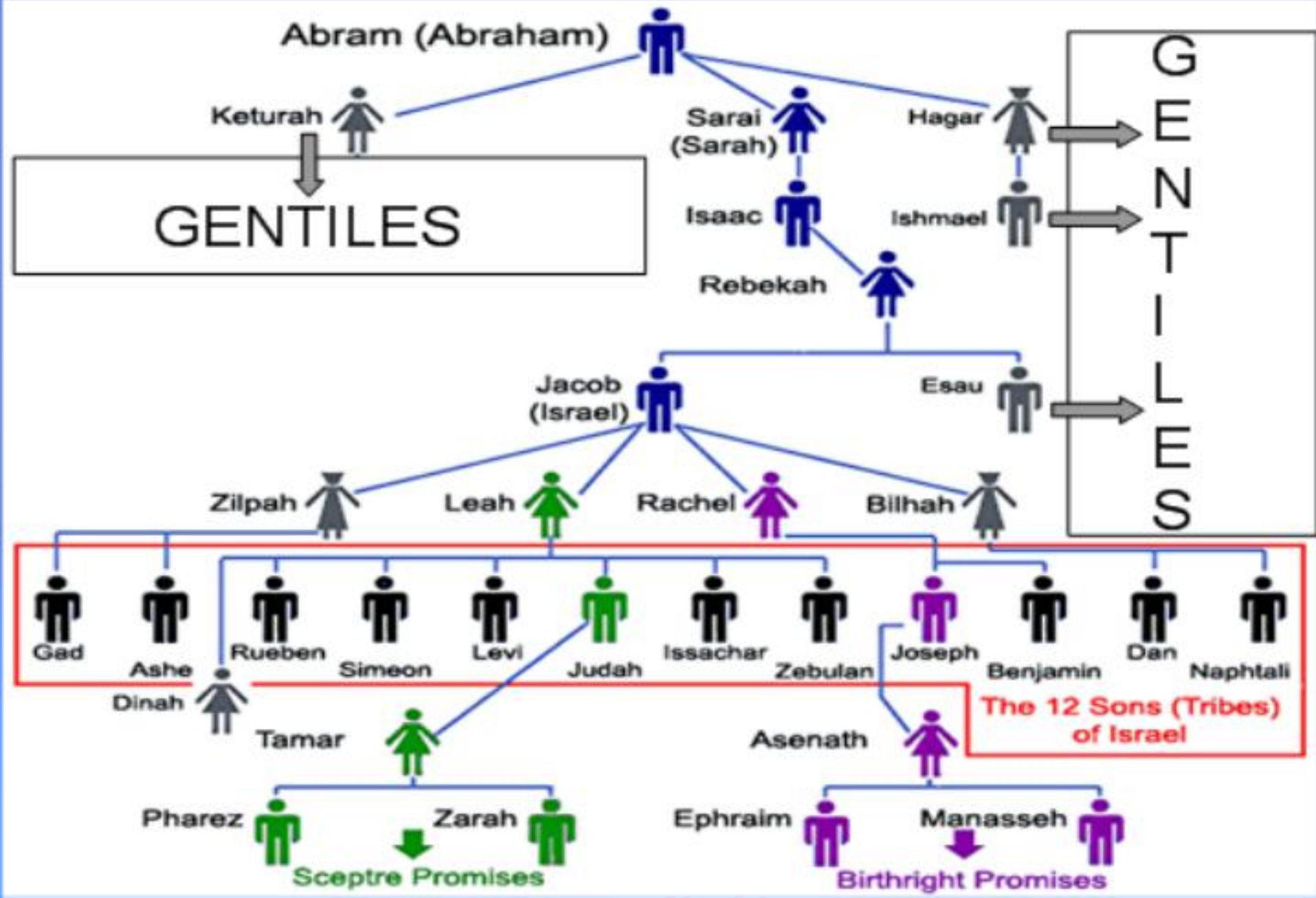
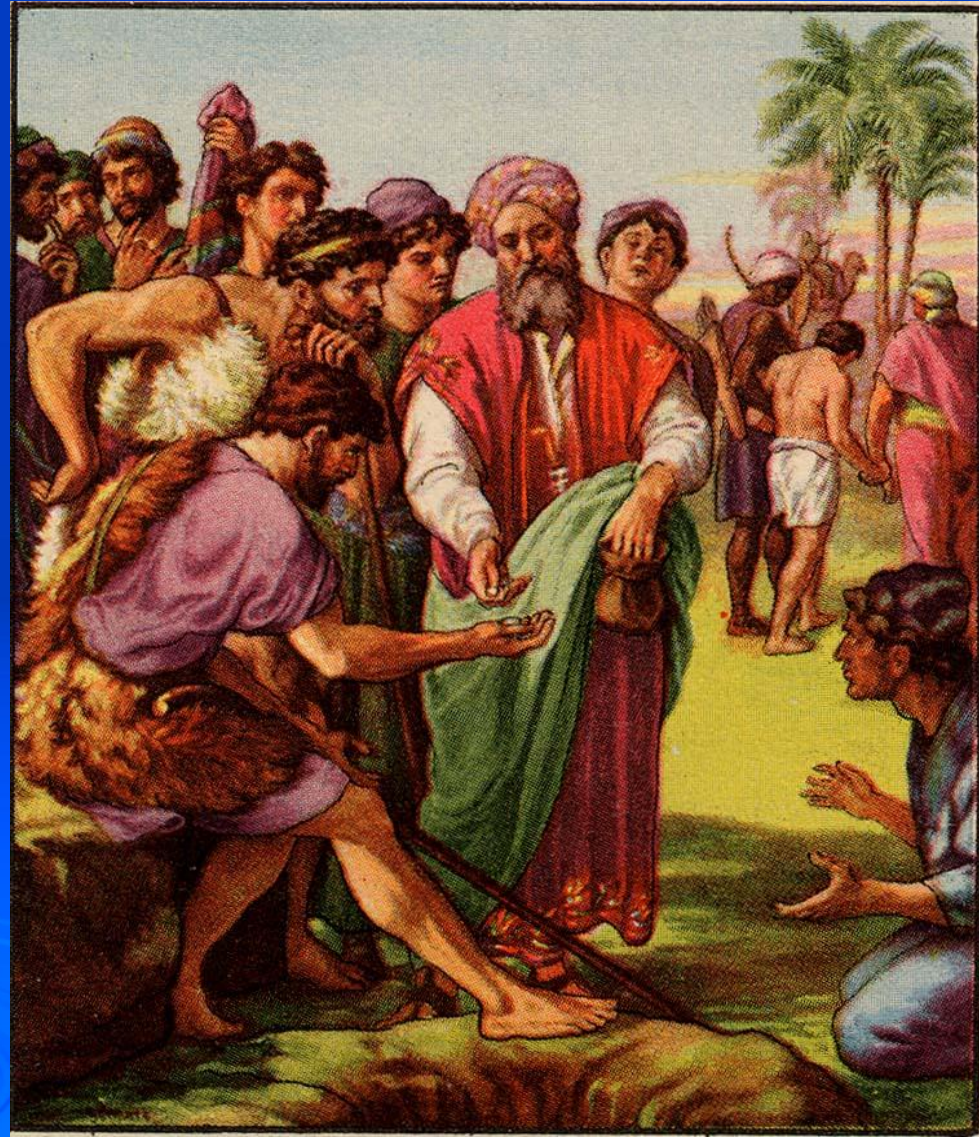


LINE OF COVENANT PROMISE



Y'HOSEPH (JOSEPH)

- 17 years old, sold into slavery
- 10 jealous older brothers tell father Jacob that Joseph was killed
- Taken to Egypt and sold to Potiphar as a house slave
- Interprets Pharaoh's nightmares and is elevated to 2nd in command of Egypt



JACOB'S CROSSHANDED BLESSING

- GENESIS 48
- Joseph's younger son Ephraim given firstborn rights
- Jacob gave firstborn rights to a GRANDSON instead of to the rightful heir, Rueben
- 1Chron.5:1



NORTHERN KINGDOM CALLED EPHRAIM



- Civil War in 922 BC split Israel into 2 Kingdoms
- Ephraim was dominant over 10 tribes
- Judah was dominant over 2 tribes
- Northern Kingdom = Israel
- Southern Kingdom = Judah

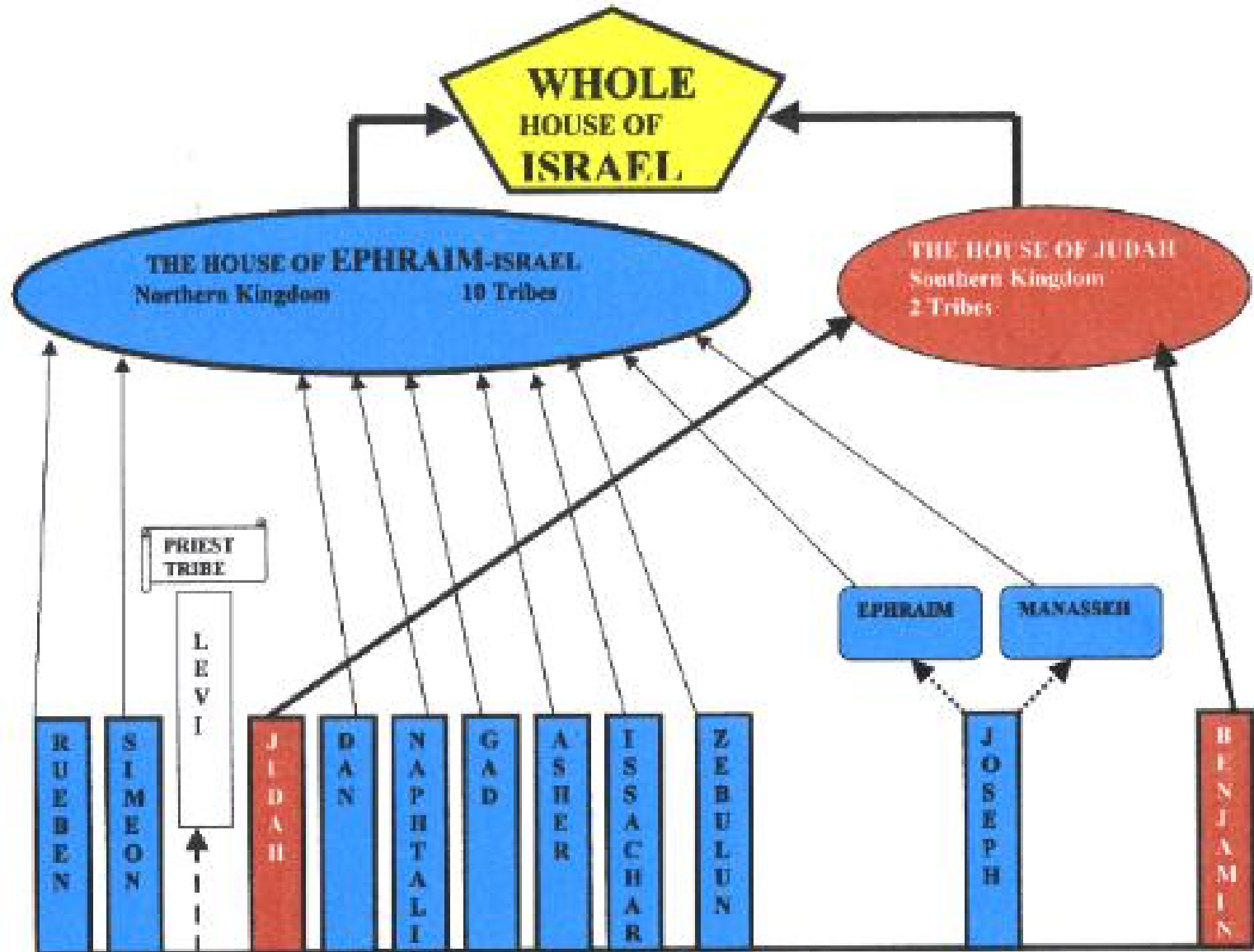

- Bible timeline discarded

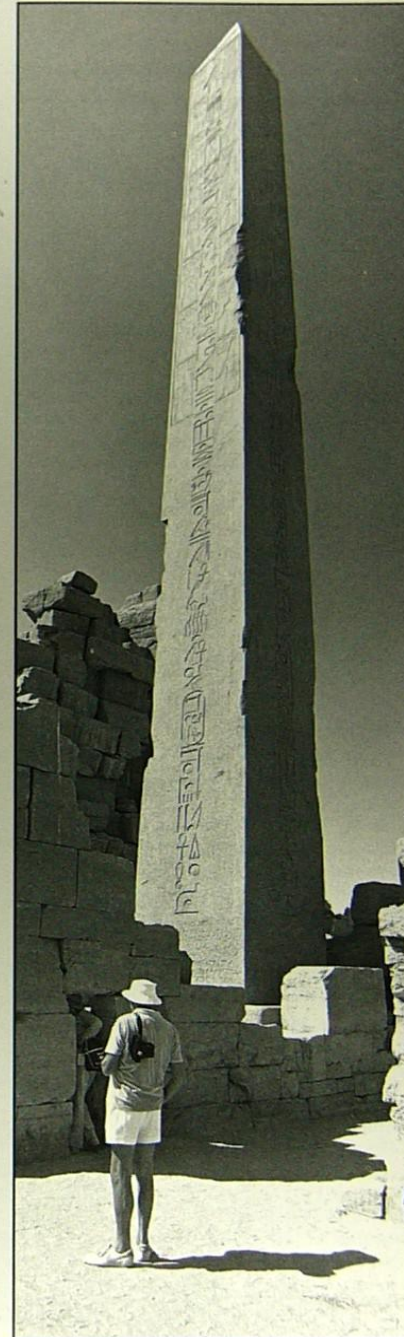

EGYPT IN TRANSITION



- Joseph dies
- First 200 years in Egypt the Israelites prospered
- Egypt was being ruled by Semite Pharaohs
- An Egyptian from Thebes overthrew the Semite Pharaohs (Hyksos rulers)
- Israelites made scapegoats and subjugated as a slave labor force
- Egyptians used to create a loyal nationalist army
- Pharaoh ordered Hebrew male babies to be killed at birth to stop the Israelite population increase

MOSHEH



- 1400 B.C.
- Moses is born to the Levites Amram & Jochebed
- Mose = born of
- Mosheh = drawn out
- Moses raised in the household of the Pharaoh
- Always knew who he was
- Moses sees an Egyptian strike a Hebrew; Moses kills the man
- He flees Egypt, across the Sinai, then across the Gulf of Aqaba, to Midian



THE BURNING BUSH

- Moses rescues some girls from being bullied, marries the Midian priest's daughter
- He becomes a shepherd in Midian
- Moses 80 years old
- Goes to Mt. Horeb, Mountain of God, later called Mt. Sinai
- Yahweh confronts Moses
- Moses accepts God's instructions to return to Egypt and rescue the Israelites



MOSES CONFRONTS PHARAOH

- Aharon (Aaron), Moses' brother, becomes spokesman
- Aharon convinces tribal leaders of Moses' mission
- Pharaoh responds by increasing Hebrews' workload
- God tells Moses His formal name: YHWH
- God's name had never before been known to mankind
- YHWH says that He will be Israel's God
