

CONNECTIONS

- Revelation 5 connects to Daniel 7 and 12
- Rev. 5 vision of One sitting on the throne, tied to Daniel's vision of the Ancient One
- One like a Son of Man of Daniel 7, tied to the Lamb that was slain in Rev. 5
- Rev. 5 is a partial fulfillment of Daniel 12

WHO IS WORTHY?



- Rev. 5:2 Even the mighty angel is unworthy to open the sealed document
- No one in Heaven, on earth, or under the earth can open it
- Not the powerful Seraphim; not a great king or holy man; not even Satan
- The contents of the vision was only finally revealed in the 90's A.D.
- The contents made Daniel physically ill
- Not knowing the contents caused John to cry and cry

- Lion of Judah connects directly to Israel
- Genesis 49:9 – 12
- “Lion of Judah” only appears once in the Bible in Rev. 5
- “Root of David” is first introduced in Rev. 5
- Other places in the Bible it is the “Root of Jesse”, David’s father
- Isaiah 11:10
- Yeshua assigned attributes like Moses
- Deut. 18:15 - 19

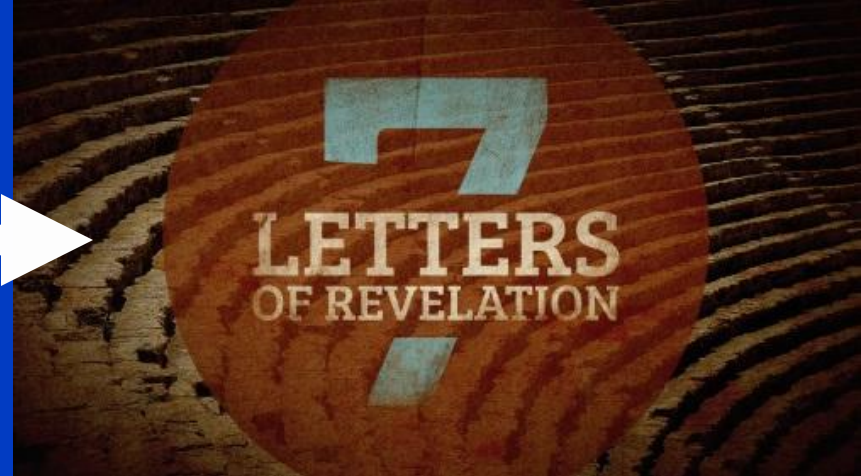
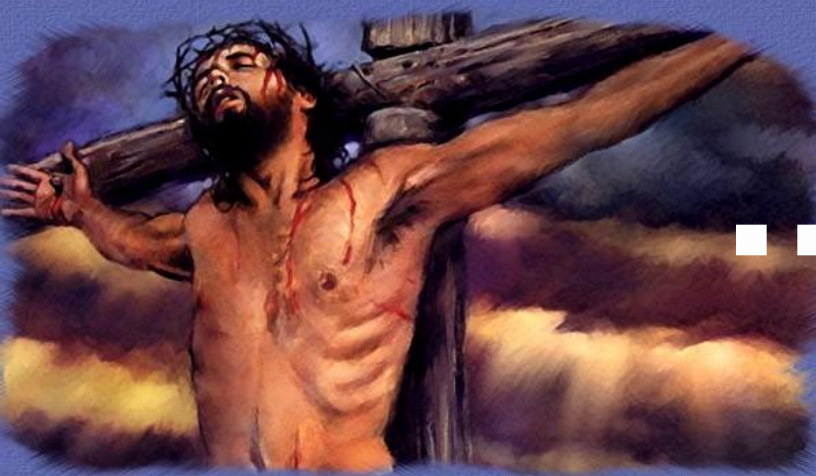




- Vss. 5 & 6 confirm that the Lamb and the Lion of Judah are the same person
- Rabbis cannot accept that the Lion and the Lamb can be one....they are opposites
- Isaiah 53:7 – 10
- Rabbis insist that Israel is the lamb that is slain



- The slain Lamb is alive !!
- Christ's Lion characteristic only happened by His being slaughtered as a Lamb
- In the New Testament, God delivers His people **THROUGH** death
- **ONLY** through His death as the Lamb did Christ win the victory and earn the right to receive the scroll



- The reward for over comers happens after death
- 1) We'll eat from the Tree of Life (eternal life)
- 2) We won't be hurt by the 2nd death (only the 1st)
- 3) A new name on a white stone (not guilty for sins)
- 4) Will rule over the nations (in the Millennium)
- 5) Given white garments (perfect purity)
- 6) Kept from trial on the whole world (we'll be dead)
- 7) Will sit with Messiah on His throne (Millennium)

THE 7'S OF THE LAMB

- 7 horns + 7 eyes = sevenfold spirit of God
- 7 can have a sense of finality
- 7's need to be viewed in their individual and collective terms
- Collectively, a perfect end
- 7 horns symbolic of perfect power
- 7 eyes refers to Zechariah chapters 3 and 4
- Zechariah 3:6-9
- 7 eyes on the stone = removing guilt from the Land
- ***Tzemach*** = branch or sprout



- Zechariah 4:1, 2 & 10
- 7 eyes symbolize the 7 lamps that allow God to have complete knowledge
- Applying this to Rev. 5, the Lamb has complete power (7 horns) and complete knowledge (7 eyes) of all that happens throughout the earth
- In order to rule over God's Kingdom, Messiah would need this expansive power and knowledge





7 SPIRITS

OR HOLY SPIRIT



- 7 Spirits of God (also sevenfold spirit of God)
- In non-biblical Jewish books like 1 Enoch there is a regularly used term “The Lord of Spirits”
- 1 Enoch 46:1 – 2 *“...for the Lord of Spirits has chosen him...”*
- “Lord of Spirits” might be connected/the same as “sevenfold spirit of God” or “7 spirits of God”



➤ MESSIAH YESHUA

- Lion of Judah
- Root of David
- Lamb that was slaughtered
- Son of Man
- When Messiah receives the scroll, 4 living beings and 24 Elders worship Him
- This is proof that the Lamb is divine
- Daniel 7:13, 14 Son of Man must also be divine



HARPS AND BOWLS

- A job of the Levites was to play the harp
- Incense bowls handled only by Temple Priests
- 24 Elders are a course of Levites and Priests
- Vs. 9 begins a hymn sung by the 24 Elders
- Singing was another job of the Levites
- Exodus 19:3 – 6
- Israel as priests only meant they could serve God
- Only the Tribe of Levi could provide the Priesthood for Temple services
