- John's visions go back and forth between events in Heaven and on earth
- Beginning chapter 18, the 21 judgments have concluded
- God uses a combination of the supernatural along with influencing the evil inclinations of humans in order to bring about His justice



THE DESTRUCTION OF BABYLON IS COMPLETE

- A special angel delivers God's message of Babylon's demise
- This event takes place on earth, and is future to us
- Ezekiel 27, 28
- Tzor and Sidon were used in the Bible as examples of peoples and places of unrestrained idolatry
- God judged Tzor not only because of her idolatry but also because she harassed God's people Israel





JEREMIAH 51

- This chapter deals with both ancient and future Babylon
- Babylon is blamed for corrupting other nations
- God urges His people to flee
- Babylon is Satan's earthly capital
- Babylon has fallen not just because she's evil, but because she seduced many others into her sins

Upside Down Church

- The Prosperity Doctrine rages within the Church, while God says to temper our desire for wealth
- Sex is sacred. Homosexuality is forbidden. Transgender defies God's order.
- Murderers are spared instead of being executed while abortion is encouraged
- Greed of wealthy businessmen who pay poorly their employees is something God hates
- All these things are the spirit of Babylon

- Matthew 7:21 – 23
- Who are “My people”? Hosea 2:1 Romans 9:20
- For God’s people to remain in Babylon is spiritual defection
- Believers **MUST**..... Take heed, admit our complicit actions, and begin an altered life

OBLIVIOUS TO THE DANGER



- We can NOT be part of a corrupt Church that protects wicked ministers, sanctions gay marriage, promotes abortion
- We cannot personally change these institutions!
- God expects us to FLEE, not to stick it out!
- 2 Cor.6:14 - 18

BABYLON PAID BACK DOUBLE



- Lex Talionis (proportional justice) to be set aside for Babylon
- Babylon's punishment for glorifying herself is an equal measure of torment and sorrow
- Babylon will pay double for what she did to others, while in equal measure for what she did for herself
- Babylon will fall in a day
- She will be burned by fire (totally destroyed)

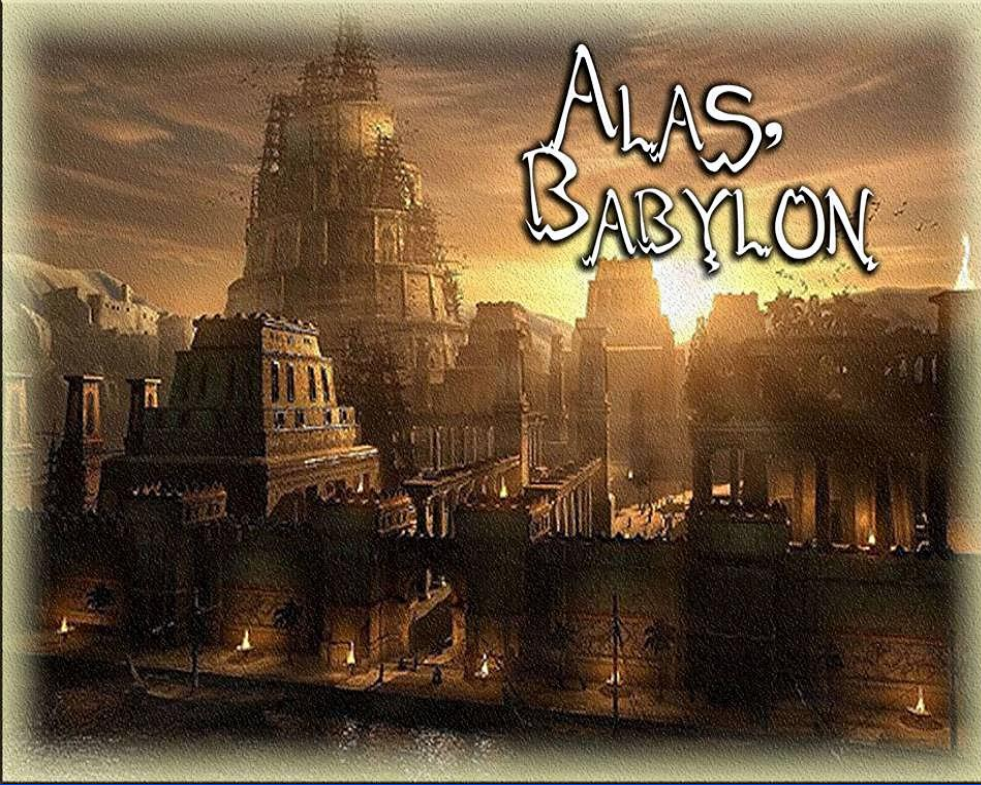
- Rev. 17:16
- God puts it into the hearts of the 10 Kings to destroy the Whore of Babylon
- Why would they kill the goose who lays the golden egg?
- Theory: a religious fervor of these 10 kings
- Who would gladly destroy the world's economic system today despite the harm it would also do to them? Islam!
- Will the anti-Christ make a deal with Islamic leaders to support him, and kill the whore, but Islam's goal is to rule the world?

TEN KINGS



**OF THE
BEAST OF REVELATION**



- Verse 9 is NOT about the 10 kings who killed the Whore, but rather other leaders who counted on Babylon for their success
- The end of the world's economic system is their ruin
- The burning of Babylon means war
- These kings/leaders stand at a distance, as cowards, afraid that if they stand up for Babylon they'll suffer
