

PAUL AND JEWISH IDIOM

- Deciphering of DS Scrolls is going to change the reading of the NT, especially letters of Paul
- Church not likely to welcome it
- Un-circumcision is not a real word... An oxymoron
- Uncircumcised = gentile
- Uncircumcision = Jew who has circumcision reversed
- How is that possible?

- Circumcision the most emphatic indication of Jewishness
- Gentiles seen as evil, not righteous, worthy only of God's wrath
- Jews saw themselves as good, righteous, worthy of God's blessing and mercy
- Paul says that circumcision is bringing these Jews a false sense of security
- Paul's Jewish readers would have been offended

THE PRIDE OF CIRCUMCISION




FROM 12 TRIBES TO ONE NATION

- Terms Hebrew and Israelite not used much in the NT era
- Y'hudi = Jew
- > 12 tribes fought for dominance. This was normal for tribal societies
- After 10 tribes exiled, only 2 remained, with Judah dominant
- "Jew" used like "American"
- Jew a national term mostly, but with a national religion

CIRCUMCISION AS A WALL OF DIVISION

- Paul intended on adjusting some bad Jewish attitudes
- ➤ If Jewish pride made them think they are righteous, what is the need for the Gospel?
- Pharisees were the teachers of "the Law", but the "law" they taught was *Halakhah*, not the true Law of Moses
- Mark 7:1 14

613 laws

Do not worship any other gods Do not make any idols Do not misuse God's name Keep the sabbath holy Do not covet

Honour your father & mothe Do not murder Do not commit adultery Do not steal Do not lie





- Because of bad attitudes, Jewish Believers seem to have nothing gentiles want!
- Matthew 22:36 40
- Love God and Love Neighbor is taken from the Torah; it is not a NT innovation!
- All the Law rests upon the pillars of Loving God and Loving our Fellow Man

- Paul says that the Jews lean on their circumcision as proof of their righteousness
- NO ONE can be truly "Torah observant"
- Always is according to some group's standard
- Is mostly *Halakhah*, plus preference, and not much Torah
- NEVER in Israel's history could all the Law be done due to varying circumstances
- YES! Believers are to do the Law (of Moses) wherever it is possible to do it
- The LAW does not save us!
- The LAW shows us how to live a redeemed life

WHAT IS A TRUE JEW?



- Vs. 25, Paul backtracks and says that circumcision DOES have value IF you do what the Law says
- Circumcision an outward sign of our inward condition
- A "real" or "true" Jew is a spiritual measure, not a physical measure
- Gentiles can be "true Jews" according to Paul's definition
- But that does not change gentiles to physical Jews, or give gentiles rights as though they were Jews

- "True Israelite" would have better expressed Paul's underlying thought than "True Jew"
- "Israel" embodiesGod's ideal of a peopleset-apart for Him
- Should not be a chapter break between Romans 2 and 3
- The glaring question: What is the point of being a Jew?





ROMANS CHAPTER 3: "Then what advantage has the Jew?"

- What he means is: considering what has been said, then does a Jew have ANY advantage over a gentile?
- If we read no further, then the answer seems to be "None whatsoever"
- Charles Cranfield: "....the question is of the credibility of God..."
- Paul next asks: "So what is the value of Circumcision?"
- Answer: "Much in every way !"
